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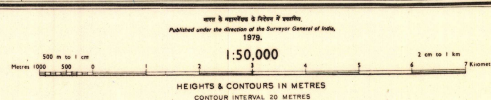
Notes:  
1. Forest: reserved, according to importance, distance more or less, as indicated by the number of dots.  
2. Gravelled roads, tracks and paths: Road-path with bridge, bridges with parapet, without. Customer road or ferry. Stream with track in bed, unbridged. Canal. Dune, masonry or rock-filled, network. Water.  
3. River banks, shoring, steep, 1 to 6 metres, over 6 metres.  
4. Dry rock water channel, with solid & rocks. Solid river.  
5. Shaded relief, Shal, Swamp, Road.  
6. Water: land, unfilled, lake, well, Spring, Tank, pond, dry, etc.  
7. Railways: broad gauge, double, single with station, under construction, etc.  
8. Other: bridge, etc. (in white, distance, etc.)  
9. Place: line or railway, Telegraph line, Casing with tunnel.  
10. Contour: with feature, Rocky, steep, etc.  
11. Sand, Shaded, etc. (in white, distance, etc.)

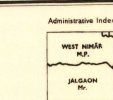

The state boundary between Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra has been surveyed as plotted up by the local officials on the ground, but has not been verified by the Government concerned.  
In Madhya Pradesh, the letter 'd' has frequently the sound of 'r'; in Maharashtra, the letter 'd' has frequently the sound of 'r'.  
Unmarked roads and contours in this sheet are generally measurable in dry season.  
Towns shown in this sheet usually contain water from the Government.  
Common forest boundaries have not been shown for want of reliable information.
