	i)	Short narrative of the proposal and project scheme for which the forest land is required	:	M/s.IDEA Cellular Ltd proposes to lay underground Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) over a lengh of 12.477 KMs. passing through the forest area of Manuguru Forest Division in Bhadri-Kothagudem District. Objective of the project is to improve the connectivity and communication facilities in State of Telangana particularly in rural areas of the State in tune with the policy of State Government and Central Government to make the rural areas digital. The project provides employment to the skilled and un-skilled people during the execution of the work and subsequent operation after
				the project is completed. OFC is laid underground all along the road by digging a trench of 0.5 mtrs width and 1 to 1.6 mtrs in depth depending on the type of soil at the edge of the road within the road boundary. The trench is filled back with and it is compacted immediately after the OFC is laid without causing any disturbance to the wildlife and it doesn't involve any tree felling.
				It does not require de-notification or diversion of the forest land but OFC is proposed to be laid in the existing Right of Way (RoW) granted to the Road Authorities. Permission is required from the Forest Authorities to lay the OFC within the road boundary in the existing Right of Way (RoW).

The total length of the proposed OFC passing through the Forest Division, Manuguru 12.477 Kms.	
				This is the only road passing through forest area which is minimum in length and there is no other route passing through the forest.

2	Purpose-wise break-up of the total land required.		:	The OFC is to be laid underground all along the road within the existing Right of Way (RoW) and in the road boundary. Diversion or de-notification of forest is not required. The total length of the route is passing through the Forest Division, Manuguru is 12.477 KMs. The Right of Way permission is required over a length of 12.477 KMs and the area comes to 12477 mts. x 0.5 mtrs = 0.6238 Ha. The entire area of 0.6238 ha. is required for laying OFC only.
