**TO WHOMSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN**

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MOEF), Government of India Letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2009 wherein the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of right under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposed, it is certified that 0.1454 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of **INDIAN OIL CORPORATION LIMITED ALLAHABAD** (name of user agency) for Retail Outlet (purpose' of diversion of forest land) in Mirzapur district falls within jurisdiction of **BAMI** village(s) in Lalganj Tehsils.

- The complete process for identification and settlement of right under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 0.1454 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultation and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s) Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure 01 to Annexure 14.
- The proposal for such diversion (with 'full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/local language), have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest-dwellers, who are eligible, under the FRA.
- The each of concerned Gram Sabhat s), has certified that all formalities/process under the FRA have been carried out, and that they given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion, A copy of certificate issued by the gram sabha of BAMI villages(s), is enclosed as annexure 01 to annexure 02.
- The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken 'pace only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram present;
- The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their content to it;
- The right of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as section 3(1) (e) of the FRA.
