Adverting to the subject and reference cited, It is informed that, the Government of India, New Delhi vide reference 6th cited, has accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 3.727 Ha of forest land in erstwhile Nalgonda division and presently Nalgonda forest division 1.692 Ha for laying of pipeline and construction of structures in Segment- 3/1 under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP Circle, Hyderabad (User Agency).

In view of the above, it is requested to deposit the following payments towards NPV and other charges as shown below.

The user agency is also requested to comply with the following in accordance with the GOI instructions issued vide F.No. 7-23/2012-FC, Dt: 24.07.2013 communicated vide Pri.CCF, AP, Hyd Re.No. 45921/2001-F4, dt: 23.08.2013, at the cost of the Project proponent:

1. Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safe guard imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers one in vernacular language and the other in English language so as to make people aware of permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non-forest purposes.
2. The copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayaths and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

Other Conditions to be complied with by the User Agency:


1. Condition No. (ii) - The demarcation of the proposed forest area shall be carried out by erecting 4 feet high cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of User Agency.
2. Condition No. (vii) - The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value of the diverted forest land measuring 1.692 Ha. from User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated.28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in I.A Nos.826 in 566 with related I.A's in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995.
3. Condition No.(ix) - Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from User Agency.
4. Condition No.(x) - The funds received from the User Agency towards Compensatory Afforestation and Net Present Value under this project shall be deposited in the respective bank account of the Telangana State CAMPA. The User Agency shall compulsorily deposit the CA and other levies only by generating challan through the Ministry's website.
5. Condition No. (xi) - Trees standing in the diverted area shall be felled strictly as per requirement with prior permission of the DFO concerned.
6. Condition No.(xii) - The muck generated in the earth cutting if any, will be disposed off at designated dumping sites and in no case the muck/debris will be disposed off in the forest areas.
7. Condition No. (xiii) - The State Forest Department shall translocate the trees, wherever feasible instead of felling at the cost of user agency.
8. Condition No.(xiv) - The forest land proposed for diversion shall under no circumstances be transferred or subleased to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government.
9. Condition No.(xv) - The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
10. Condition No. (xvi) - Details of list of trees enumerated in the table designated for the same in part II of the online FC application may be uploaded and confirmation in this regard shall be reported along with the compliance report.
11. Condition No.(xvii) - Minimal disturbance should be ensured by creating labour camps outside the forest area as far as possible and it will be the responsibility of the UA to ensure that the labourers & staff engaged in execution of work do not destruct nearby forest flora & fauna.

12. Condition No.(xviii) - The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 1.692 Ha and the forest area diverted shall not be used for any purpose other than those shown in the diversion proposal.
13. Condition No.(xix) - User Agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules Regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
14. Condition No.(xx) - Any other conditions that the Central Government or Addl.PCCF(Central) of Regional Office, Chennai may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency.
15. Condition No.(xxii) - In the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the user agency is liable for penal action as decided by the Additional PCCF (Central), Regional Office, Chennai.

With reference to the above, this is to inform that in the reference 1st cited, the Government of India accorded Stage-I approval U/s 2 of FC Act, 1980 for laying of pipeline and construction of structures in Segment No.3/1 (AKBR) under Telangana Drinking water supply project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP Circle, Hyderabad subject to fulfillment of conditions stipulated therein.

In the reference 3rd cited, the Pri.Chief Conservator of Forests & HoFF, Hyderabad requested to raise demand notice with the user agency for payment of Net Present Value (NPV), cost of CA, construction of cement concrete pillars etc.

Therefore, the following revised demand notice is issued to the user agency partially modifying the demand notices issued vide references 5th & 6th cited, to deposit the amounts.

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With reference to the above, it is informed that vide reference 3rd cited, the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF) communicated the stage-I approval accorded by the GOI, U/s 2 of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 for diversion of 0.225 Ha (Re-diversion) of Forest land in Lalgadimalakpet RF for laying of pipeline and construction of structures in Segment No.3/1 (AKBR) under Telangana Drinking water supply project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP Circle, Hyderabad.

Further, vide reference 5th cited, Pn. Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), TS, Hyderabad has requested to raise demand over the User Agency for deposition of funds into CAMPA account for NPV, CA etc and construction of Boundary Pillars, Extraction of free growth etc., in DFO account.

Therefore, the demand notice is issued to the User Agency as hereunder

As per Condition No.2, it is proposed to construct 38 Nos. 4 feet height cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 Mtrs. over a length of 0.375 Km. on either side of pipeline @ Rs.7,000/- per pillar (as per present unit rate) for Rs.2.66 lakhs.

The User Agency is requested to deposit an amount of Rs.2.66 lakhs in favour of District Forest Officer, Medchal.

As per Condition No.8, the User Agency has to pay an amount of Rs.1.4085 lakhs towards Net Present Value @ Rs.6.26 Lakhs per Ha. for Eco-class- III consisting of dry deciduous forest (open forest) as per classification of forest in the Compartment history with density varying around 0.2 as per rate fixed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India as per guidelines issued by Government of India vide File No.5-3/2007/FC,dt.05.02.2009.

The User Agency is requested to deposit the amount of Rs.1.4085 lakhs towards Net Present Value in by generating challan online into the adhoc CAMPA Account of Telangana and submit copy of the same to this office.

Hence, the User Agency is requested to pay the above amounts immediately and submit compliance report on the other conditions stipulated by the Government of India vide reference 1st cited (mentioned above) and also furnish copies of paper clippings having published the forest clearance so as to enable this office to submit compliance report to the Nodal Officer for according final approval by the Government of India.
