



Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
A relative height, .s, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
A relative height, e.g., .s, against a wall, indicates its total depth in metres.
Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
Wells and tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet. Only the important ones have been shown.
Unmetalled roads in this sheet are generally not usable in dry season.
The area adjoining the Hidan River is liable to change owing to continual fluctuation in the course of the river.
The kilometre stone numbers along roads, railways and canals are shown in start type, e.g., 17 whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., 17.
