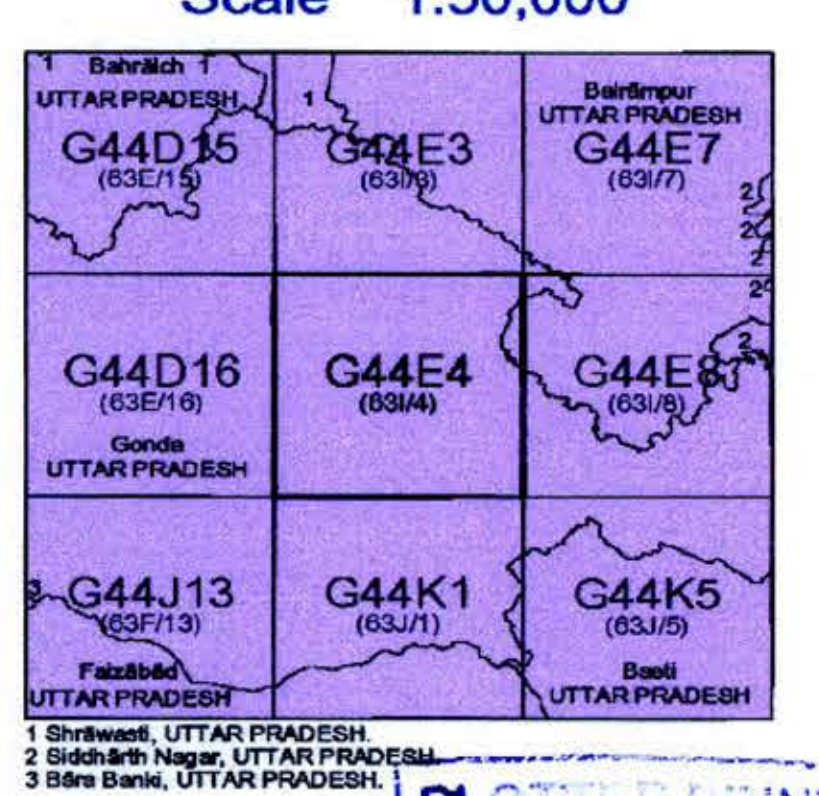

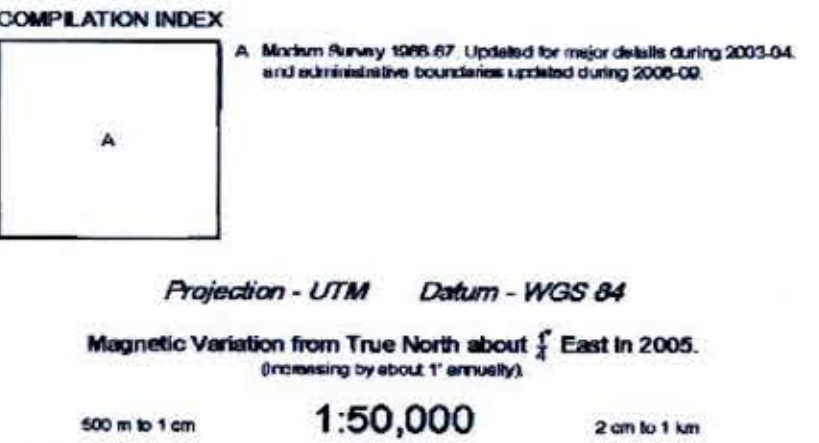
A relative height, e.g., 50, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
