



NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
A relative height, e.g., 2r, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a contour line. Buildings are shown in black with names.
A relative height, e.g., 30r, against a well, in blue, indicates its total depth in metres.
Tanks shown dry, in this area, usually contain water from July to November.
Canal distance stones are 1,000 feet apart and every existing fifth stone is shown.
Under well symbols indicate covered tanks, called Kundis which usually contain surface collection of rain water and indicate water.

3,000 acres = rectangular stones of Bhakra Dams Project Surveys and with their numbers are shown as tertiary benchmarks thus, X² 489 BM 207 8


