It is informed that the Government of India, vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited, has accorded inprinciple (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 4.675 Ha of forest land in Paloncha division and presently Manuguru forest division for laying of pipeline for Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Khammam (User Agency) duly stipulating certain conditions to be complied and communicated by the PCCF, TS, Hyderabad vide reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited.

Further it is informed that, in the reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited above, the undersigned has issued Demand Notice for deposit the funds. In the reference 5<sup>th</sup> cited above, the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, TS, Hyderabad has issued instructions to revise the Demand Notice. Accordingly a Revised Demand Notice has been prepared and submitted to Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, Hyderabad and is was accepted on 09.08.2017 through e-mail. Therefore it is requested to deposit the following payments towards NPV, CA Scheme and other charges as shown below.

The User Agency has to generate Challan online and deposit funds into the UTR.No.generated online. Further, the above payment through e-portal method only by generating generating challan at Ministry's web portal i.e., forestsclerance.nic.in. To generate the challan, the UA has to enter the details of demand notice raised in Ministry's web portal, which has to be vetted by the Nodal Officer, FCA, Telangana State. Then only the challan has to be generated for depositing into any one of the Telangana Compensatory Afforestation Funds (CAF)/ Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) specific CAMPA Saving bank Account maintained in the Bank mentioned below:

The user agency is also requested to comply with the following in accordance with the GOI instructions issued vide F.No.7-23/2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide PCCF, AP, Hyderabad Rc.No.45921/2001-F4, Dated:23.08.2013, at the cost of the Project proponent:

- Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safe guard imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers one in vernacular language and the other in English language so as to make people aware of permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non-forest purposes.
- 2) The copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

## Other Conditions to be complied with by the User Agency:

- The Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.
- The demarcation of the proposed forest area shall be carried out by erecting 4 feet high cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of user agency.
- The Compensatory Afforestation (CA) shall be raised and maintained by the State Forest Department over 4.675 Ha. Out of the 187.677 Ha. Of Non-forest land identified in Sy.No.169 of Peddamunagala and in Sy.No.139 & 147 of Thimmapuram in Chandampet Mandal of Nalgonda District at the cost of user agency.
- 4. The State Government has proposed 4.675 Ha, of non-forest land for compensatory afforestation under the subject proposal as part of 187.677 Ha, of non-forest land identified for entire TDWSP projects (Mission Bhageeratha Project). The CA land identified to the extent of 187.677 Ha, for the Mission Bageeratha Project under the working control of WLM division, Nagarjunasagar shall be apportioned project wise including the CA area identified for the present proposal and all the relevant details like DGPS coordinates, map, soil suitability certificate etc. shall be uploaded in the Ministry's online portal against the subject proposal.
- Identified CA land shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
- Non-Forest land identified for raising compensatory afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department before issue of the Stage-II clearance.
- Non-Forest land which is transferred and mutated in favour of the state Forest Department for the purpose of Compensatory Afforestation, shall be declared as Reserved Forest under section-4 or Protected Forest under Section 29 of the Indian Forest act, 1927 or under the relevant section(s) of the local forest act.
- The User Agency shall pay the Net Present Value of the diverted forest land measuring 4,675 ha, as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated.28.3.2008 and 09.05.2008

- The funds received from the User Agency towards Compensatory Afforestation and Net Present Value under this project shall be deposited in the respective bank account of the Telangana State CAMPA. The User Agency shall compulsorily deposit the CA and other levies (other than cost of construction of boundary pillars, extraction of tree growth) only by generating challan through the Ministry's website, as explained above.
- Tree standing in the diverted area shall be felled strictly as per requirement with prior permission of the Forest Divisional Officer, Manuguru.
- 12. The muck generated in the earth cutting if any, will be disposed off at designated dumping sites and in no case the muck/debris will be disposed off in the forest areas.
- 13. The User Agency shall pay the cost towards translocation of the trees, wherever feasible instead of felling as proposed by the Forest Divisional Officer, Manuguru.
- 14. The forest land proposed for diversion shall under no circumstances be transferred or subleased to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government.
- The layout plan for the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
- 16. Details of list of trees enumerated in the table designated for the same in part II of the online FC application may be uploaded and confirmation in this regard shall be reported along with the compliance report.
- 17, Minimal disturbance should be ensured by creating labour camps outside the forest area as far as possible and it will be the responsibility of the UA to ensure that the laborers & staff engaged in execution of work do not destruct nearby forest flora & fauna.
- 18. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 4.675 Ha. and the forest area diverted shall not be used for any other purpose other than those shown in the diversion proposal.
- User agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provision of the all Acts, Rules Regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
- 20. Any other conditions that the Central Government or Addl. PCCF (Central) of Regional Office, Chennai may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency.
- In the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the user agency is liable for penal action as decided by the Additional PCCF (Central), Regional Office, Chennai.

After receipt of the compliance report on the above mentioned conditions the proposals will be considered for final approval. Transfer of forest land to the user agency shall not be effected prior to the issue of final approval. This in-principal approval is valid for the period of (5) years. In the event of non compliance of the above conditions, this in-principal approval shall automatically stand revoked after (5) years.
