In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC(pt) Dated: 03.08.2009 wherein the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter Dated: 05.02.2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified for diversion of **0.84 Hectares** of Forest Land proposed to be diverted in favour of **The Executive Engineer, P.R, P.I.U Division, Nellore** (name of user agency) for "**Construction of road from Podalakur - Rapur road to Gilakapadu (Via) Veerayapalem on Pothukonda extn.II RF of Gilakapadu Beat of Marlapurdi Forest Section in Venkatagiri Forest Range of Nellore Forest Division of Rapur Mandal**" falls within jurisdiction of Veerayapalem village in Rapur Mandal.

- a. The complete process for identification and settlement of Rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire **0.84 Hectares** of Forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee is enclosed as annexure A & B.
- b. The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA has been completed and the Grama Sabha have given their consent to it.
- c. The proposal does not involve recognised rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre - agricultural Communities.
