Heights and Contours have not been shown.  
A relative height, *h*, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.  
The kilometre-slash numbers along roads and canals are shown in slant type, e.g., 5/2 whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type e.g., 5/2.  
Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.  
Numerous wells exist throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.  
Unmetalled roads and cart tracks are generally roads suitable for dry seasons. Permission to use those along canals is required from the irrigation authorities.  
Prices shown crossable by ferry with period over the Kollia Nadi, are for boats for the remaining part of the year.  
The area adjoining the Docha or Gorra River is liable to change owing to continual fluctuation in the course of the river.
