NOTES

The kilometre stone numbers along the railway, roads and canals are shown in slant type, e.g., '5' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., '5'.
Cart-tracks and unmetalled roads in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use those along canals is required from irrigation authorities.
Wells are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.
Areas unfit for cultivation due to layers of calcareous soda are shown as 'Waste land'.
Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
