in compliance of the ministry of Environment and forest (MOEF) Government of india's Letter No. 11-9/98-FC (p.t.) Dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the scheduled tribes and other traditional forest dwellers (Recognition of Forest rights) Act. 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non forest purpose, it is certified that compartment No **PF-387, 357/1** total area **13.775** hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Water Resources Division Umaria for construction of Dam in Umaria District falls within jurisdiction of **Sigudi & Kuthuliya Village in Manpur Tehsil**

It is further certificated that :

- The complete process for identification and settlement of right under the FRA has been carried out for the entire **13.775** hectares of forest land proposed for diversion A copy of record of all consolation and meetings of the forest committee (s), Gram sabha (s), Sub division level committee (s) and the district Level committee area enclosed as annexure 1 Annexure.....
- The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implication in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram sabha of forest dwellers who are eligible under the FRA.
- The each of concerned gram sabha (s), has certified that all formalities/processes under the FRA have been carried out and that they have given their consent to the proposed the FRA have been carried out and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures if any having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion , A copy of certificate issued by the gram sabha of **Sigudi & Kuthuliya Village (s)** is enclosed as annexure 1.....
- The discussion and decisions on such proposal had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% for the members of gram sabha present:
- The diversion of forest land facilities managed by the government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the gram sahba have given their consent to it.
- The right of primitive tribal groups and pre-agricultural communities where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1) of the FRA.
