The kilometre stone numbers along the railway and roads are shown in stem type, e.g. '5' whereas whereas kilometre numbers are shown in upright type, e.g. '5'.

All cart-tracks along canals are motorable in dry season, permission to use these is required from the irrigation authorities.

The state boundary between Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh States has been surveyed as pointed out by the local officials on the ground but has not been verified by the Government of Madhya Pradesh. Road from Mahoba to Kumbhara shown as first importance as per field records but its number is not given as per chart provided by NTA.
