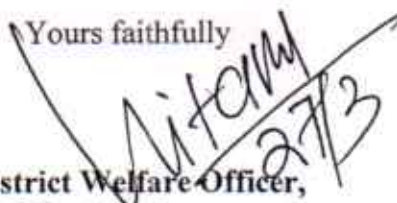

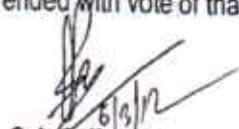

The District Welfare Officer, Angul was instructed to prepare the Certificates accordingly.

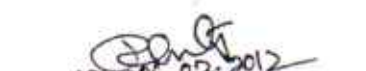

After careful consideration, it was decided that, in consonance to D.O No. 17593 / Dt. 24.10.2009 of Chief Secretary & Chief development Commissioner, Odisha, Bhubaneswar, the Certificate in form-II (Revised format) for Diversion of forest land for project purposes shall be issued in favour of Radhikapur (West) Coal Mining Pvt. Ltd. by the Collector & Chairman, District Level Committee, Angul.

Agenda No. 2. The DWO raised the difficulties while issue of certificate under Forest Right Act-2006 for diversion proposal of different linear projects (Form -1) as per Resolution No. 11-9/98-FC(pt) / Dt. 05.02.2013 & Dt. 05.07.2013 of Govt. of India MoEF (FC Division).

The Committee advised DWO, Angul to get the records of all consultations and meetings of FRC(s), SDLC(s) regarding proper implementation of FRA as well as safeguard of rights of PTG / PAC as per resolution issued by Govt. of India.

There is an ambiguity regarding issue of certificate for linear projects in Form No. 1. As per Resolution, where linear diversion of use of forest land in several villages are involved, unless recognized rights of PTG / PAC are being affected, are exempted from the requirement of obtaining consent of the Concerned Gram Sabha(s). But in Form I, Point-(a), it has been mentioned to obtain copy of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Right Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and District Level Committee are to be enclosed while issuing of certificate.

The Collector & Chairman DLC advised the DWO, Angul to seek for clarification from Govt. in Forest & Environment Department, Odisha, Bhubaneswar regarding the difficulties while issuing of certificate for linear projects in Form-1.

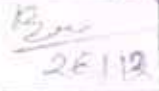
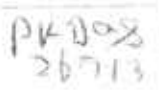

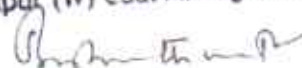
