


CONTOUR INTERVAL 20 METRES

Wooded areas are coloured green. Scattered trees and other vegetation are in green, but prominent surveyed trees are in black.

The triangulated heights and contours in this sheet have not been adjusted to the heights of the spirit-levelled bench-marks and may not be strictly in accordance with them.  
Cart-tracks and unmetalled roads in this sheet against which there is no descriptive remark are generally jeepable in dry season.  
The kilometre stone numbers along roads and railways are shown in slant type, e.g., '5' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., '5'.  
Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to February.  
Periodical cultivation occurs in the non-perennial portion of Orsang River bed during summer.  
Cactus hedges generally exist along cart-tracks and field bunds.
