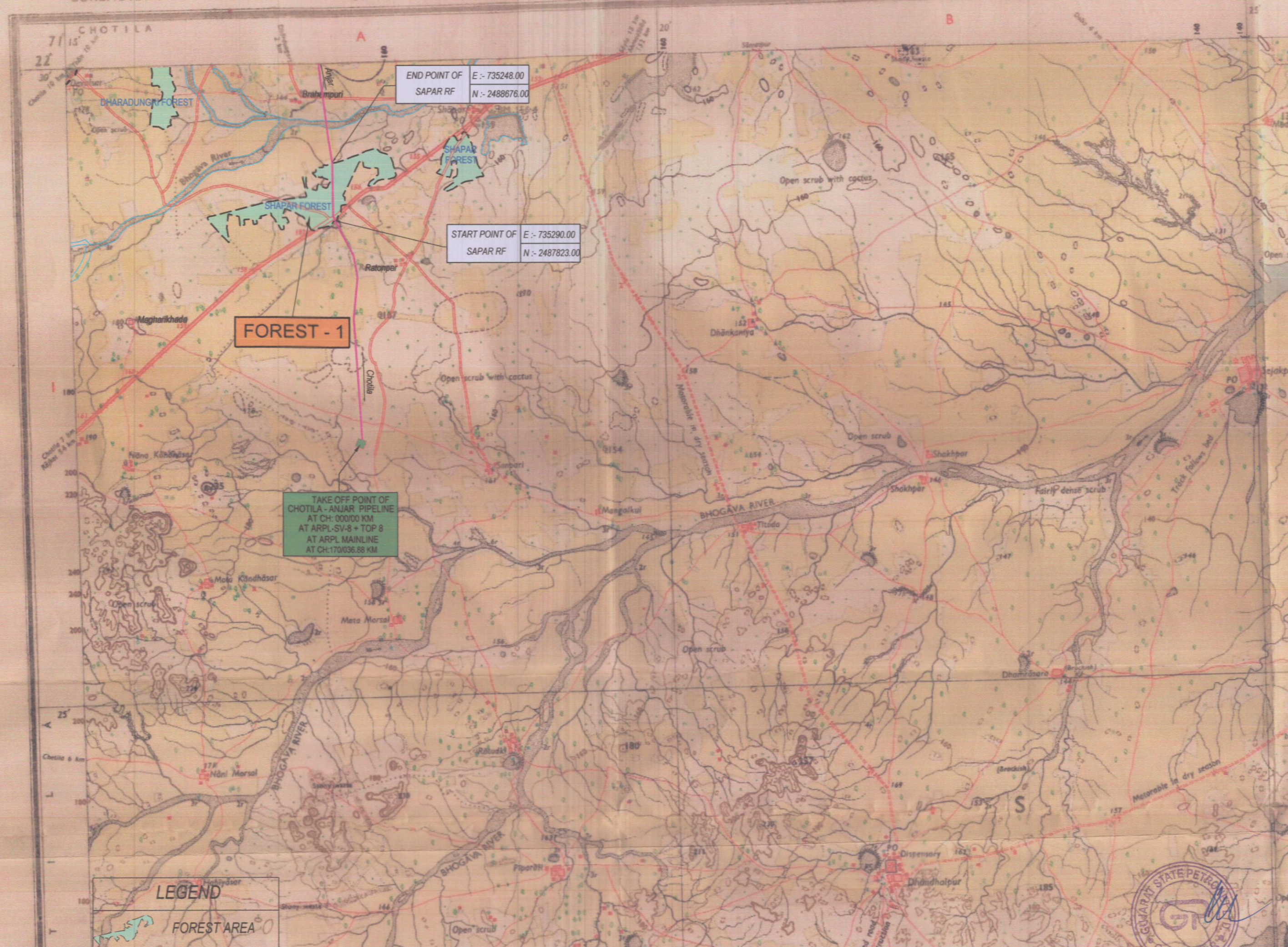

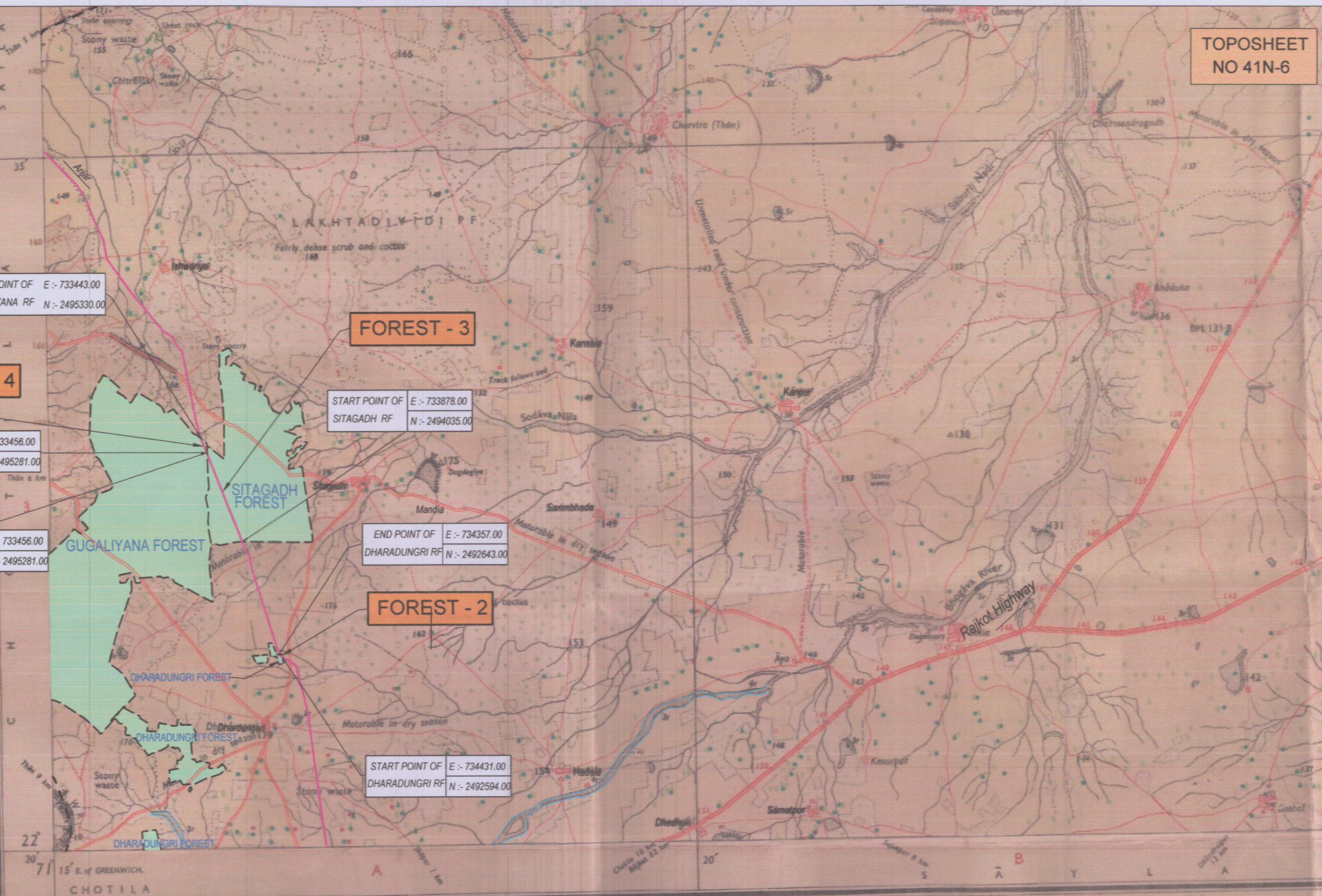

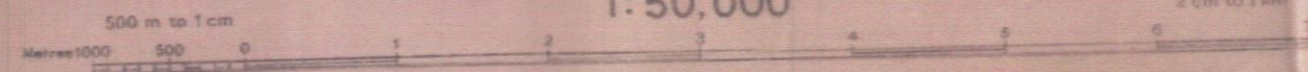

CONTOUR INTERVAL 20 METRES

Water features are shown in blue where they generally contain water.
Cultivated areas are coloured yellow.
The exterior boundaries of areas of Reserved or Protected Forests are shown by green ribands.

Contours are approximate.
A statue height, dr, represents the approximate height in metres between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
Wooded areas are coloured green, scattered trees and other vegetation are in green, but prominent surveyed trees are in black.

The kilometre stone numbers along roads and railways are shown in plain type, e.g. '5' whereas milestone numbers are in bold type, e.g. '5'.
Tanks, shown dry in this area usually contain water from July to September.
A relative height, e.g., dr, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent canal.
