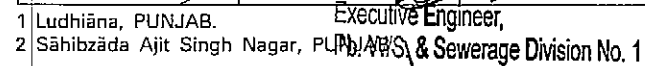
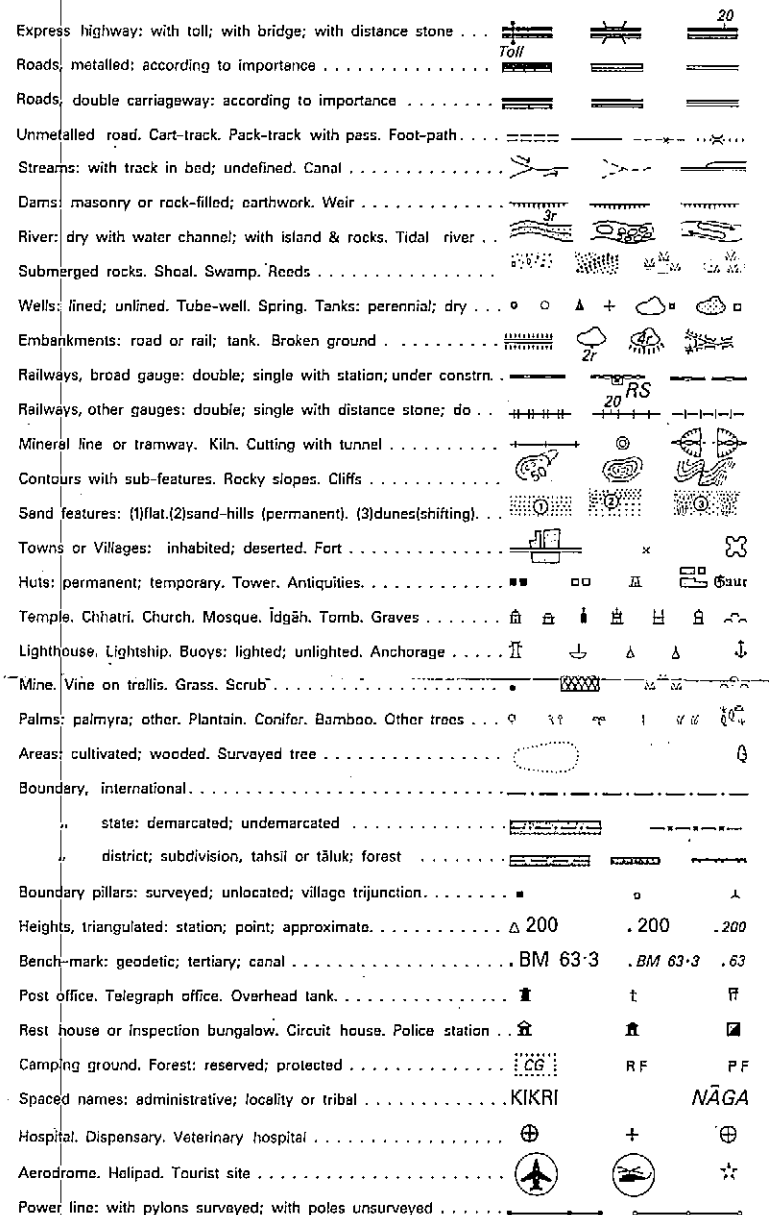

Height is in metres above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximations.

a) Relative height, e.g., -8 represents the approximate height in metres between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

b) Canal tracks and unmetalled roads along canals are motorable throughout the year. Permission to use the canal banks for other purposes must be obtained from the irrigation authorities. Other track-roads and unmetalled roads are generally unusable during dry season.

c) Relative height, e.g., +3 marking along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjoining country.

d) Tails shown dry, i.e., in the area usually contain water from July to December.

e) Tail-weirs are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.

f) The course of the Ghagghar River is liable to continual change owing to shifting of the river bed.

g) All canal tracks and positive embankments are 1000 feet apart and every existing fish stair is shown.

The state boundary between Haryana and Punjab States has been surveyed as pointed out by the local authorities.

The places of Antiquarian importance falling in square numbers D4, E/2 and F/3 belong to Moghul period. These are unoccupied monuments.

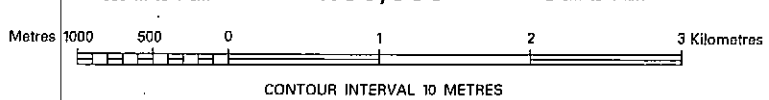

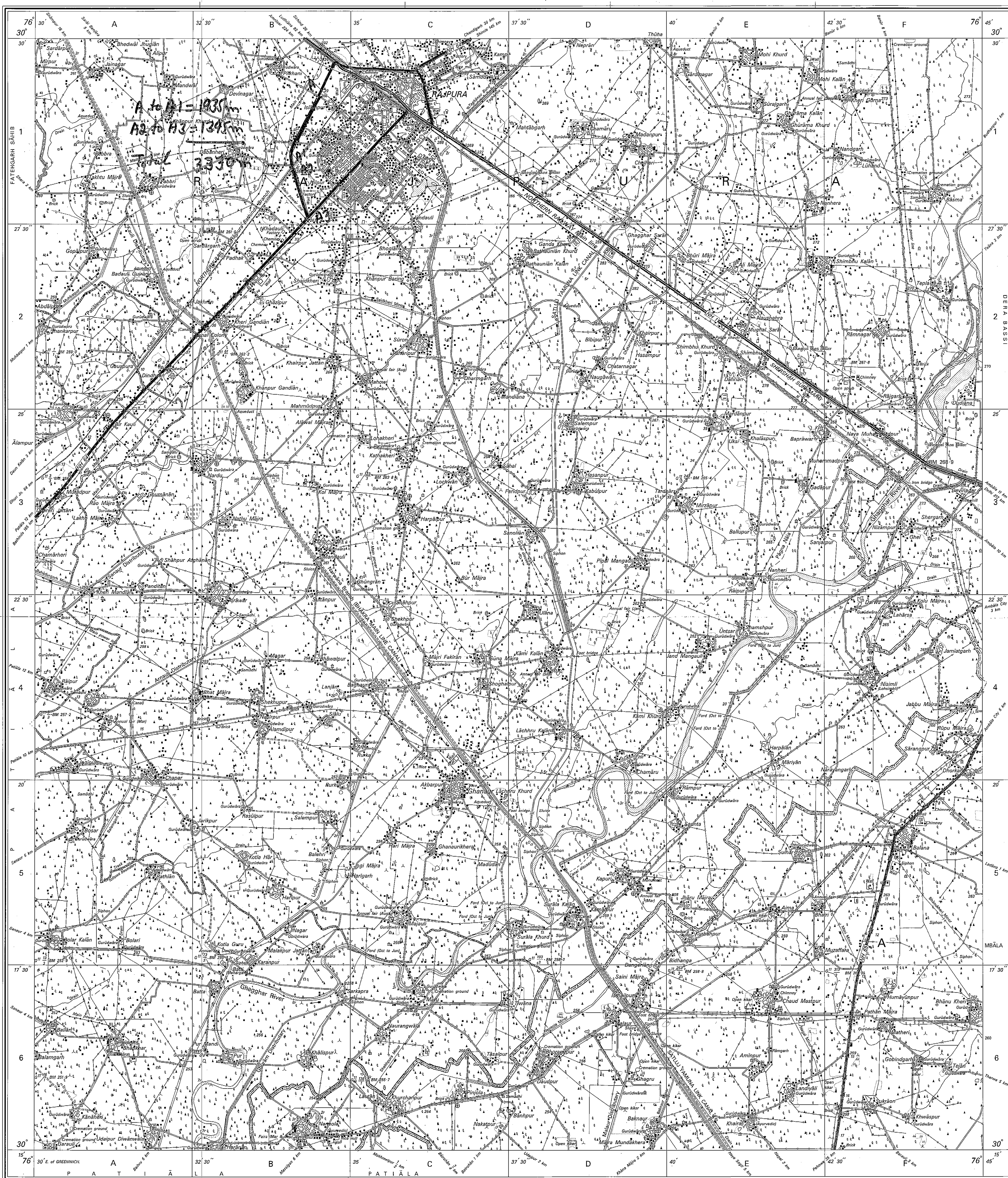
