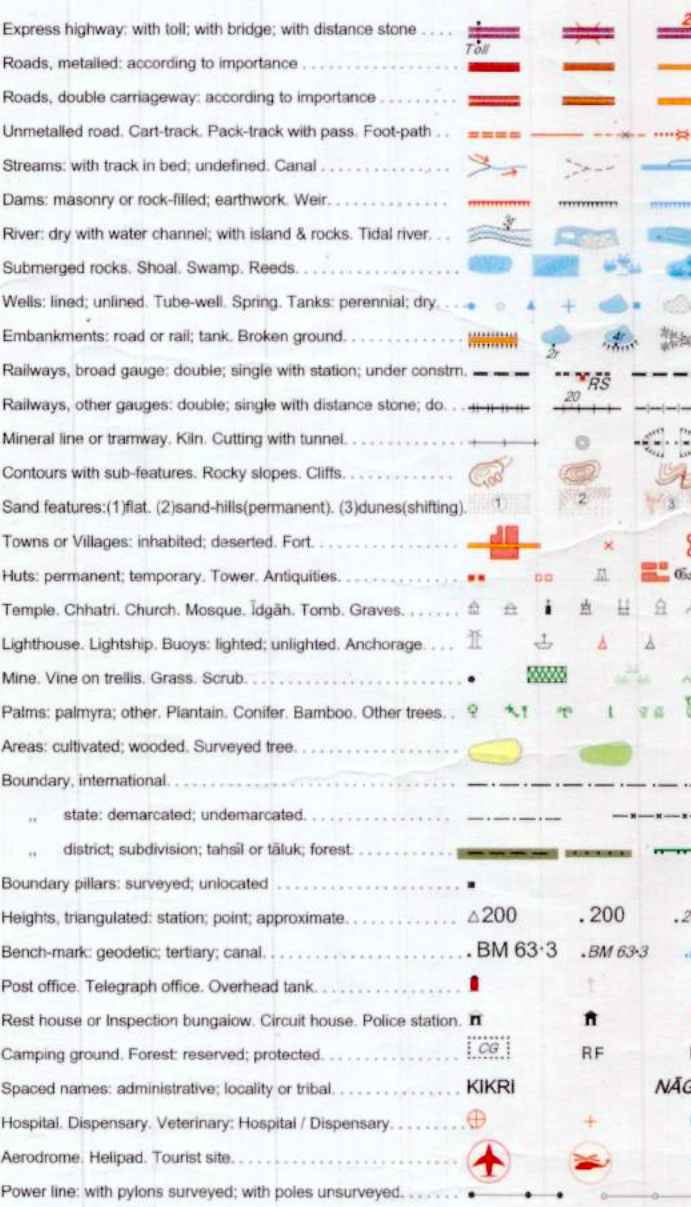




CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

Heights and Contours have not been shown.
A relative height, e.g. 10, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
Huts are numerous, some have been omitted to bring out their relative distribution.
Unmetalled roads and most of the cart-tracks are motorable in dry season.
