

Justification for location the project in forest land and details of  
alternatives examined

M/s Vindhya Telelinks Limited have got license of IP-1 provider. The scope of IP-1 Provider is limited to establish & maintain assets such as Dark Fibers, Right of Way, Duct Space and Tower for the purpose to grant on Lease/Rent/Sale basis only to the licensed Telecom Service Providers licensed under section-4 of Indian Telegraph Act 1885 on mutually agreed terms & conditions.

With a view to ensure connectivity, company is laying Optical Fibre Cable along the road side as per the agreed policy of Government of India and per GO No. 1485/नौ - 9-2012-161ज/12 dated 15.10.2012 issued by the Chief Secretary, Government of UP.

Since, the Fibre is to be connected end to end between the stretch District Fatehpur along with road on Jahanabad-Sadh Marg 2.75 Km., Bhognipur-Ghatampur-Chaudagra Marg 1.250 Km., Jahanabad-Amauli-Chandpur-Jafarganj-Joniha Marg 42.800 Km., Shivrajpur-Bindki-Lalauli Marg 17.00 Km., Bahuva-Chillaghat Marg 7.00 Km. & Joniha-Shahbajpur Marg 1.7 Km. Total Length 72.5 KM. & 0.7511 Ha. In Forest Division/Social Forestry Division Fatehpur, District: Fatehpur, UP and the same stretch falls under Forest hence the permission to lay Optical Fibre Cable is being required. It is the minimum requirement of Forest land and there is no alternative for this Forest Land.

We have done the survey and find that there is no alternate route available to lay the Fibre and to connect the same with the other end. Hence it is requested that permission may kindly be granted.
