

CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

- Express highway: with toll; with bridge; with distance stone
- Roads, metalled: according to importance
- Roads, double cartway: according to importance
- Unmetalled road: Car-track; Path-track with pass; Foot-path
- Draughts: with track in foot; unmetalled; Canal
- Dam: masonry or rock-filled; earthwork; Weir
- River: dry with water channel; with island & rocks; Tidal river
- Submerged rocks, Shoal, Swamp, floods
- Well: hand; tubewell; Spring; Tanks: perennial; dry
- Embankment: road or rail; tank; Broken ground
- Railways, broad gauge: double; single with station; under construction
- Railways, other gauge: double; single with distance stone; do
- Mineral line or tramway: K.M. Cutting with tunnel
- Contours with sub-features: Rocky slopes; Cliff
- Sand features: (Hills) (Sand-hills) (permanent) (Sukravahing)

NOTES

- Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
- Contours are approximate.
- A relative height, *h_r*, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
- The kilometre stone numbers along the railway and roads are shown in upright type, e.g. 5. Whence distance numbers are shown in upright type, e.g. 5.
- Unmetalled roads and cart-track in this sheet are generally metalled in dry season. Permission to use these roads is granted to be reported from the irrigation authorities.
- Wide are metalled throughout the sheet; the important ones have been shown.
- Tanks shown dry in this area, usually contain water from July to March.
- A relative height, *h_r*, or marked along a canal indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
