In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidence for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 179.38 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Sukurangi Chromite Mines of M/s OMC Ltd. for chrome ore mining and ancillary activities in Jajpur district falls within jurisdiction of Ostapal, Saruabil, Sukurangi, Tailangi, Kamarada & Forest Block- 27 (Mahagiri DPF) villages in Sukinda tahsil.

(j) the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it;

(f) the rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per Section 3 (1) (e) of the FRA.
