Sukarangi, Talangi in the dist. of Cuttack.

ORDER :

Whereas Orissa Mining Corporation has
applied to the State Government for grant of a Mining Lease by their
application read above;

Whereas the mineral in the land in respect of
which the mining lease has been applied for belongs to Government and
the land is at their disposal;

Whereas the applicant holds a valid Certificate
of Approval from the State Government;

Whereas the applicant being a Limited Company
is registered in India;

Whereas the Government of India have conveyed
their approval to the grant of Mining Lease under Section 5(2)
of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957
and also in exercise of the powers conferred by section 30 of the
said Act, directed the State Government to take into consideration
this application and pass orders thereon at an early date.

Whereas Government of India have relaxed the
provision of rule 58(1) of M.C. Rule 1960.

Whereas the Orissa Mining Corporation Ltd. has
agreed to the incorporation of special condition " that the chromite
produced from the Mines by the Corporation will be first offered to steel
Authority of India to meet their requirement " in the lease deed
under rule 27(3) of the M.C. Rules, 1960.

Whereas the party was asked in Mining and Geology
Department letter No. 7021 MG dated 31.7.78 to accept the terms
and conditions under which the Mining Lease was proposed to be considered for
grant and the party in his letter No. 11853 dated 31.7.78 accepted
these conditions;

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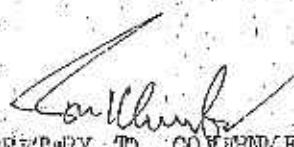
Therefore, the State Government are hereby pleased to order that a Mining lease in respect of the land over 467.42 Hects. be granted to Messrs. O.M.C. Ltd. subject to the conditions laid down in the State Government letter No. 7021 dated 31.7.78. The party should comply with all the terms and conditions including furnishing of a surveyed map and description within 3 months from the date of this order to the Collector, Cuttack.

Sub: Extension of validity period of Mining Lease for Chromite of **M/s OMC Ltd.** over an area of 382.709 Ha in village Sukrangi, Saruabil, Ostapal, Tailangi, Kamarda and Forest Block-27 in Jajpur district.

ORDER:

Whereas a mining lease was granted for Chromite in favour of M/s. OMC Ltd. over an area of 382.709 Ha in Village Sukrangi, Saruabil, Ostapal, Tailangi, Kamarda and Forest Block-27 in Jajpur district for a period of 20 years w.e.f 20.09.1980.

Whereas the said lease expired on 19.09.2000;

Whereas the 1st RML application was filed on 19.09.1999 over the entire area in due time.

Whereas Section 8A(8) of Ordinance dated 12.01.2015 of Ministry of Mines, Govt. of India, speaks as follows.

"Notwithstanding anything contained in this Section, the period of mining lease, including existing mining leases of Government Companies or Corporations shall be such as may be prescribed by the central Government".

DGM (422) Oko Whereas Ministry of Mines Government of India in their order dated 06.02.2015 have clarified that the tenure of mining leases of all Government companies or corporations whose mining leases have expired and renewal applications have been made in time or which are due to expire on or before 31.03.2020 will stand to be extended till 31.03.2020.

Therefore, the State Government are hereby pleased to order that under section 8A(8) of the MMDR Ordinance read with clarification No.1/2/2015 M.VI dated 06.02.2015 of the Ministry of Mines, Government of India, the period of validity of the Mining Lease for Chromite of **M/s OMC Ltd.** over an area of 382.709 Ha in Village Sukrangi, Saruabil, Ostapal, Tailangi, Kamarda, and Forest Block-27 in Jajpur district is extended till 31.03.2020.
