NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.

Contours are approximate.

A relative height,  $\delta$ , represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.

Wells and tube-wells are numerous throughout this sheet; only the important ones have been shown.

Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks in this sheet are generally metalled in dry season.

Permission to use unmetalled road and cart-tracks along canals is required from the local authorities.

The kilometre stone numbers along railways and roads are shown in slant type, e.g. 57, whereas mile-stones, numbers are shown in upright type, e.g. 35.

Depressions in this area are usually flooded from July to September.

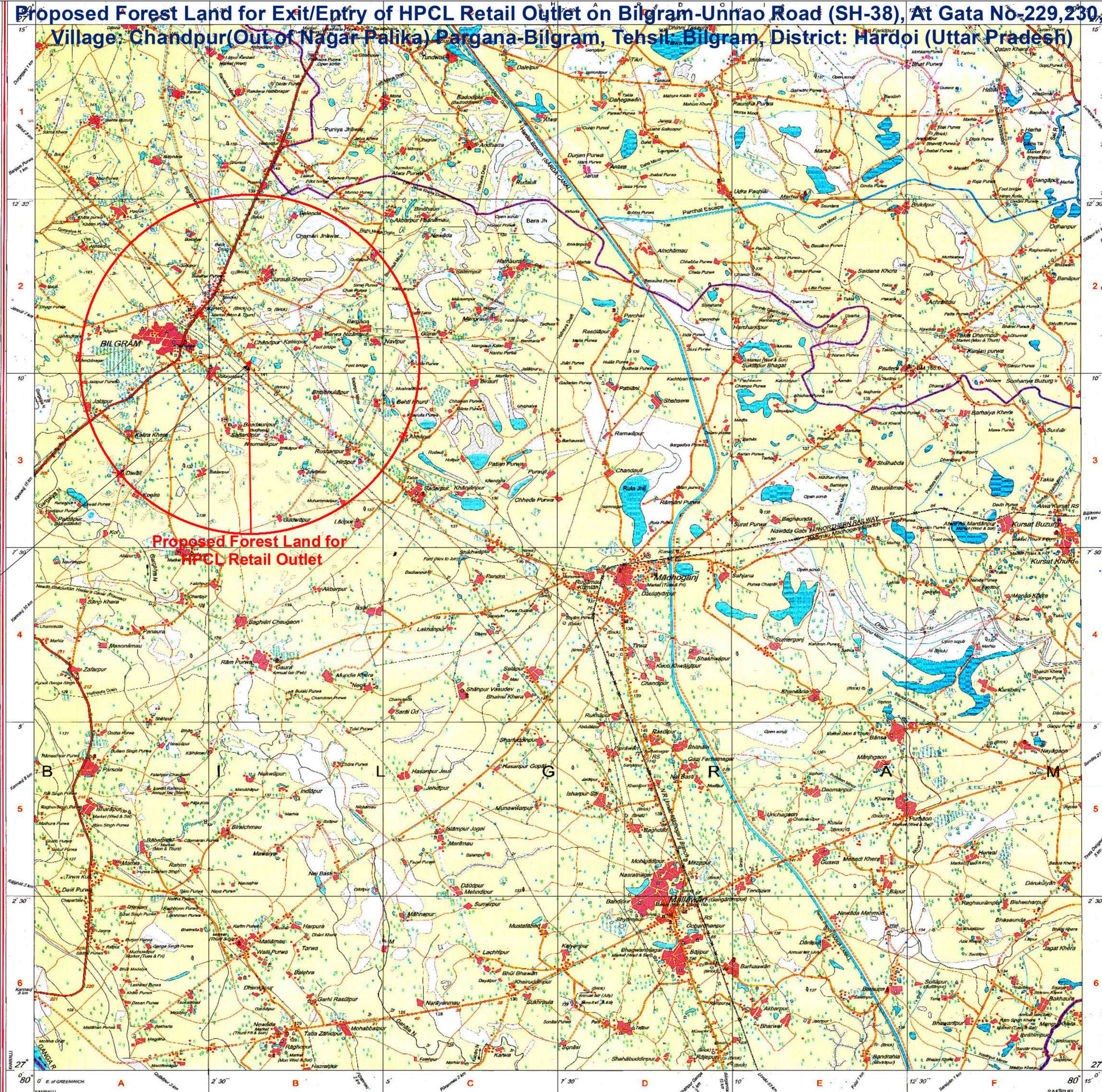
