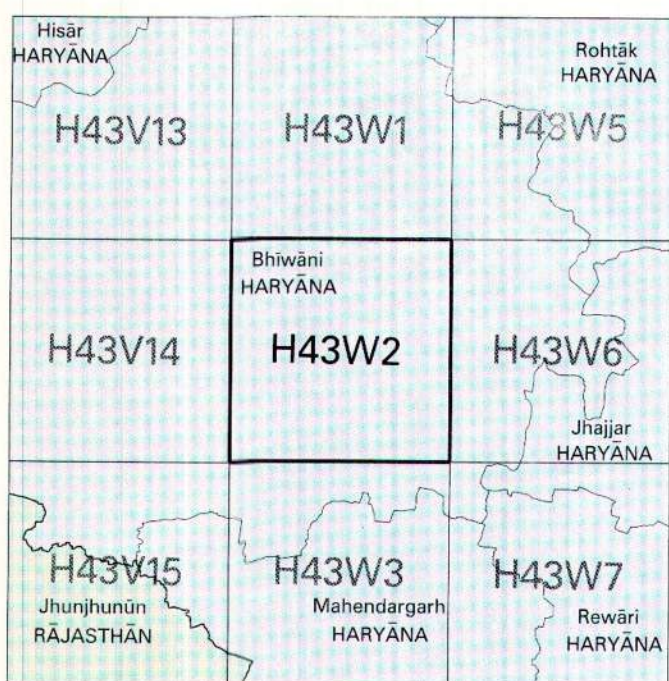

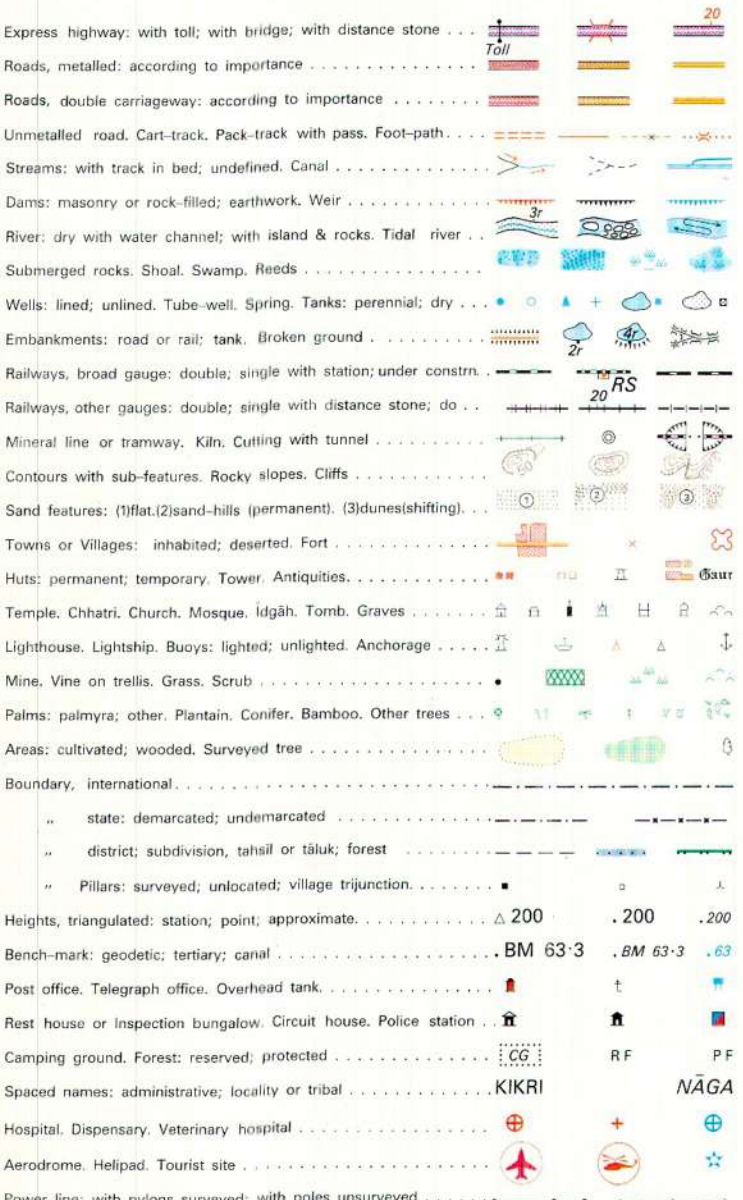


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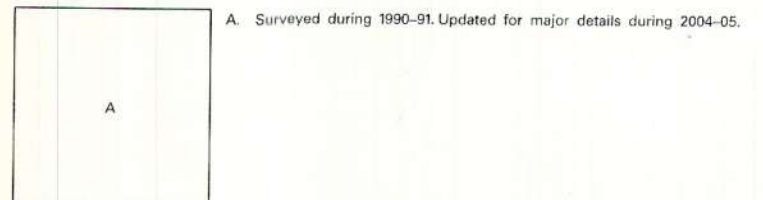
CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS



NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
A relative height, e.g. 3r, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use those along canals is required from the Irrigation authorities.
Canal distance stones are 300 metres apart and every fifth stone is shown.
3,000-acre rectification stone of Bhakra Dam Project Surveys with their numbers are shown as tertiary bench-marks thus: 13 151 BM 244-1.

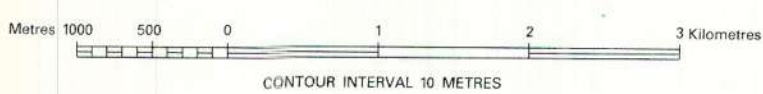
COMPILATION INDEX
