

NOTES :-
 A relative height e.g., 50, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
 A relative height, 50, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
 Permission to use cart-tracks and unmetalled roads along canals is required from the Irrigation authorities.
 Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to March.
 Tides are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
 Canal distance stones are 1000 feet apart and every sailing 5th stone is shown.
 The area adjoining the Beas River is liable to change owing to continual fluctuation in the course of river.
