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It is to inform that in the reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited, the Pri. Chief Conservator of Forests, (HoFF), A.P. Guntur, while communicating the In-Principle (Stage-I) approval approved for diversion of 347.64 Ha (Originally proposed as 469.18 ha) of forestland in (12) RFs of Eluru Forest Division for Chintalapudi Lift Irrigation Scheme package-I & II in favour of C.E., Godavari Delta System, Dowlaiswaram, AP has marked a copy of the same to the S.E, PIPRMC Circle Eluru for information and necessary action.

In this connection, it is requested to furnish the compliance of conditions stipulated therein by the G.O.I, for according stage - II approval. The Conditions to be complied with are shown below:



Further it is informed that, as per the proceedings of the District Collector, Visakhapatnam in Rc.no.3856/2008/E1, dt:11-06-2015, an extent of 519.88 ha. of non-forest land (Revenue land) is earmarked for Compensatory Afforestation. Accordingly the Compensatory Afforestation scheme has been prepared as per site conditions. The outlay of Compensatory Afforestation scheme is as follows.

The CA scheme prepared including advance operations, Raising Plantations, Maintenance of plantations upto 7<sup>th</sup> year, SMC works, Chain link mesh duly erecting concrete poles etc., The project will be taken-up from 2017-18 onwards till 2025-26 under ANR model i.e. 200 plants per ha. as per the site conditions. Hence, the demand may be raised from Divisional Forest Officer, Eluru.
