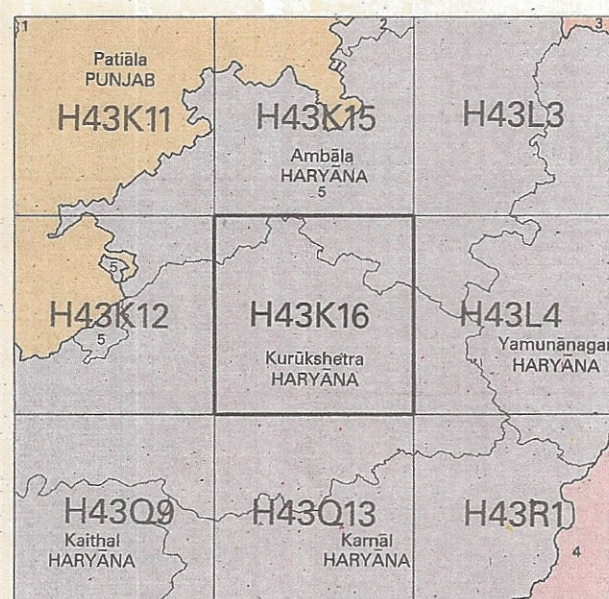

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CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

Crosses: highway; with toll; bridge; with distance stone. 

Roads: marked according to importance. 

Roads: double carriageway; according to importance. 

Unimproved road: Cart-track, Pack-track, with posts. Foot-path. 

Streams: with track in bed, unforded. Canal. 

Dams: masonry or rock-filled; cartwheel. Weir. 

River: dry with water channel; with island & rocks. Tidal river. 

Shimmered rocks: Rock. Swamp. Reeds. 

Wells: lined; unlined. Tuff-hole. Spring. Tanks: perennial; dry. 

Embankment: raised or rail; plain. Broken ground.

The course of Miranda River is liable to continual change.
Distance towns along Narvina Branch (BHARNA KANAL) and protective embankments are 1,000 feet apart. The only existing fifth stone is shown between SATTUJI YAMUNA LINK CANAL, these are in kilometres.

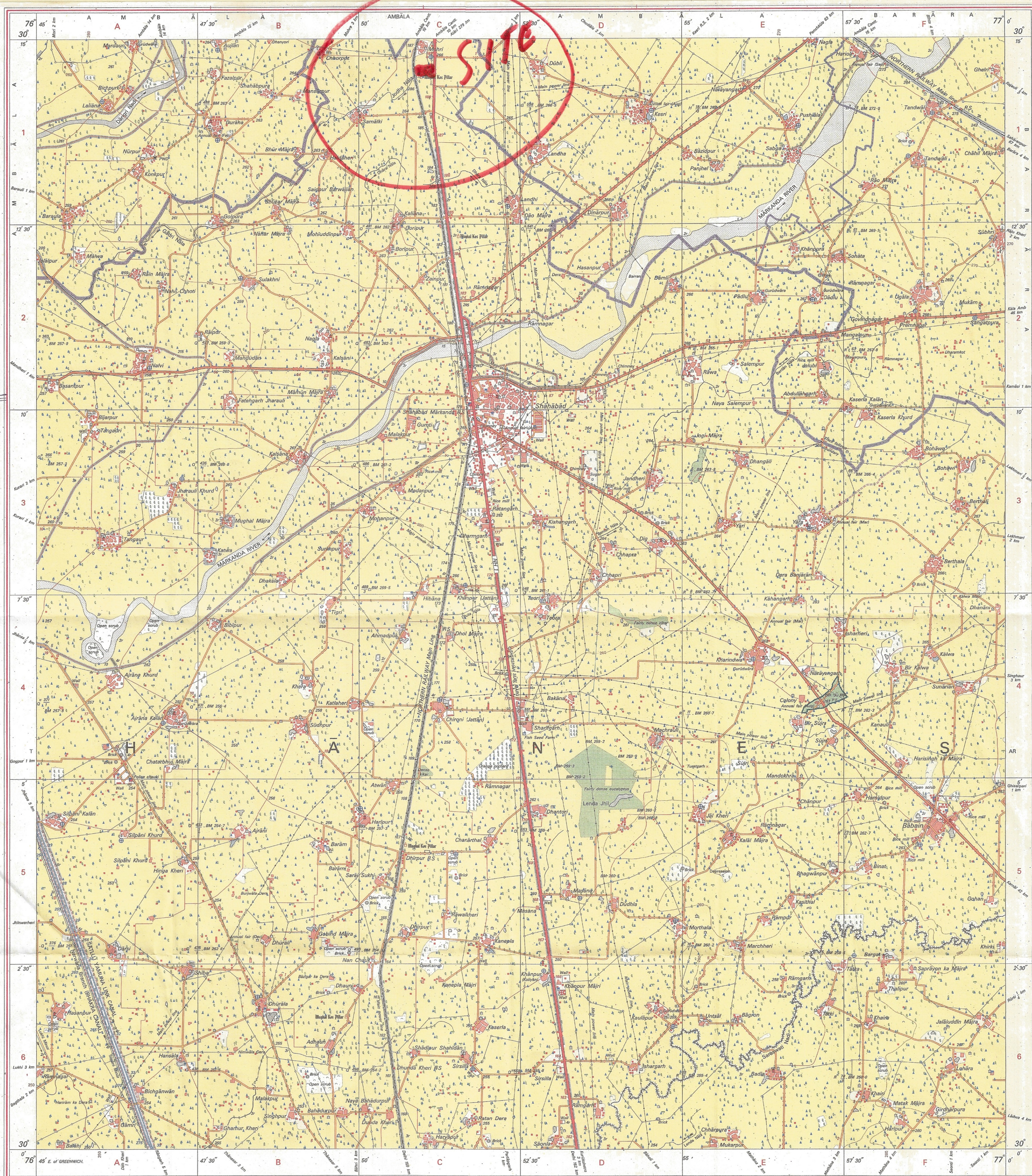
