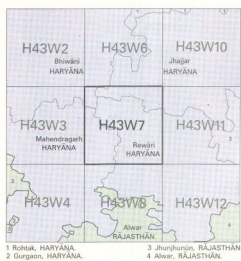

A relative height ± 40 , marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
Tanks shown in this map usually contain water from July to December.
Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
Unmarked roads and car-tracks in this area are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use those along a canal is required from the Irrigation authorities.
Cattle distance stores along Sikandara channel are 556 feet apart and every existing hill stone is shown and in other canals these are 1,020 metres apart, every existing one is shown.
