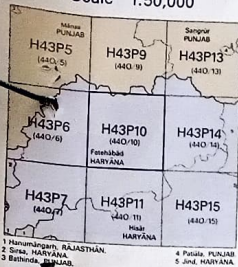




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SURVEY OF INDIA

NOTES:

heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet only the important ones have been shown.
All canals and surface water courses are important throughout the year. Permission to use these is required from the appropriate authorities. Other canals and unregulated meads are generally not available in dry seasons.
A relative height, e.g. : marked along a canal indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
Coast distances between rivers are 1000 feet apart and every existing 99th contour is shown.
The river distance between the *Brahmaputra* and the *Assam Valley* is given as 600 miles by the land route; the shortest direct distance across the Bay of Bengal is 700 miles.
The area covered by the sheet is approximately 100,000 square miles.
3,000 acre reclamation zones of British East India Company are shown on 10° N. 85° E. 10° S. 85° W. with their numbers are shown as railway branch-line numbers.
