

The transportation of the minerals proposed to be raised from the mining lease:

- All the Coal produced from the mine to be directly transported to plants by rail. Provision has been made to keep sufficient stock of coal at the mine site, which will take care of feeding the downstream in case of any breakdown. The block is well connected by road.
- The transportation of Coal to the nearest railway siding to be carried out through trucks/conveyor.
- At present the nearest railway station is at Jarapada, where private railway siding is under development stage, which is 10km from the block.
- There is a proposal for MCRL rail corridor on south of the block. Once the corridor becomes operational, the new Radhikapur siding at Putagadia will be only 1km from the block.
