

Justification for location the Project in forest land and details of alternatives examined

M/s Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd (A company Promoted by Reliance Industries Ltd), formerly

Infotel Broadband Services Ltd have got license to operate 4th Generation Broadband Wireless Access Services (4G) and implement Fibre to Home Networks across 23 States.

With a view to ensure connectivity, company is laying Optical Fibre Cable along the road sideas per the agreed policy of Government of India and as per GO No. 1485/ 9-2012-161a/12dated 15.10.2012 issued by the Chief Secretary, Government of UP.

Since, the Fibre is to be connected end to end between the stretch in District Dehradun along

road at Hill Side on road Lohari Tyuni length 60 km and Tyuni Mori till Khoonigad 19 KM. Total distance 79 KM Total area of forest land 0.79 Ha, in forest division of Chakrata in District Dehradun UK and the same stretch falls under Forest land hence the permission to lay Optical Fibre Cable is being required. Itis the minimum requirement of Forest land and there is no alternative for this Forest land.

We have done survey and found that no tree felling will be done in the said project and since it's a linear project it will be done along road side.
