



NOTES :-

A relative height, Δh , represents the approximate height in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
All cart-tracks and unmetalled roads along canals are motorable throughout the year. Permission to use these is required from the canal authority. Other cart-tracks are usually motorable except during the rainy season when they are 1200 feet apart and may vary with 500 feet stone is shown except along Trinalla Minor and Lambi Distributary where these are 1200 metres apart and existing one is shown.
Most of unfilled well symbols indicate open tanks, called Diggis which usually contain little of canal water.
The state boundary between Haryana-Punjab, Haryana-Rajasthan and Punjab-Rajasthan states has been surveyed as pointed out by the local officials on the ground but has not been verified by the Government of Rajasthan state.


