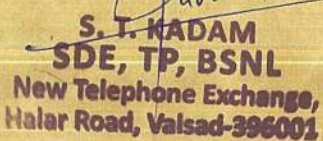

The winged hatched eggs and contents in this sheet have not been adjusted to the heights of the spirit-levelled bench-marks and may not be exactly in accordance with them.

The information marks around reads are also in such type, e.g. "F" whereas information marks are shown in upright type, e.g. "T". Read it to be wanted signal, extending along the Kildgallagh Hill Bench Mark, Permian, use this read is required from the Irigineen entrance. A relative height, e.g. as marked along a road, indicates the height of the top of the road embankment above the adjacent country.

Unmarked reads in this sheet are generally unimportant in any sense.

Corrections to this sheet are generally payable in any season.

Tests, shows, etc. in this area usually occur from July to December.

Collection is possible and dependent on rainfall.
