NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
 Contours are approximate.
 A relative height, .3r, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
 A relative height, e.g., .2r marked along a canal indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
 All cart-tracks and unmetalled roads along canals are motorable throughout the year. Permission to use these is required from the irrigation authorities. Other cart-tracks and unmetalled roads are generally motorable in dry season.
 Canal distance stones are 1,000 feet apart and every existing fifth stone is shown.
 Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to March.
 Tide-gauges are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
 A piece of Antiquarian importance falling in Square No. F/6, belongs to Mughal period. This is protected monument maintained by Archaeological Survey of India.
 The state boundary between Haryana and Punjab States has been surveyed as pointed out by the local officials on the ground but has not been verified by the Governments concerned.
 3,000-acre rectangulation stones of Bhakra Dam Project Surveys based on Origin 30°00' N, 75°15' E with their numbers are shown as tertiary bench-marks thus E⁷ 133 .BM 207.9.

 (Increasing by about 1' annually).




