In the reference 3rd cited, demand notice was issued to the Superintending Engineer, R&B Regional Office, Warangal for making payment towards compensatory levies to a tune of Rs.3,57,91,113/-, as per the acceptance issued by APCCF (FCA), O/o the PCCF, TS, Hyderabad vide reference 2nd cited.

The SE, R&B Regional Office, Warangal vide reference 5th cited while referring to the above demand notice issued by the FDO has requested Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, TS, Hyderabad to reconsider the demand issued on certain components mentioned therein as this is a government project. Accordingly, the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, TS, Hyderabad has requested this office to reduce certain amount mentioned against certain components and accordingly to raise revised demand note with the User Agency.

Accordingly, the following revised demand note is raised for making necessary payment through e-Payment mode on Ministry's portal (www.forestclearance.nic.in).

As per the conditions stipulated, the User Agency has to make the payment of the following Compensatory Levies into the accounts indicated:

The User Agency has to deposit an amount of **Rs. 2,41,84,088.00 (in words Rupees Two Crores Forty One lakhs eighty Four thousand and eighty eight only)** through online mode only in the Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) saving bank Account maintained in the Corporation Bank, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road New Delhi-110003.

The payment has to be made through e-portal method at MoEF&CC, GOI, New Delhi portal i.e., forestsclearance.nic.in by generating the challan in consultation with Nodal Officer, Telangana State Forest Department.

The User Agency has to deposit an amount of **Rs. 32,04,100.00 (in words Rupees Thirty two lakhs four thousand one hundred only)** into the PD Account of Forest Divisional Officer, Mahadevpur bearing **A/c No. 37306496587, in SBI Bank Kataram IFSC code: SBIN0020529**

Further the Superintendent Engineer, R&B Warangal (Urban) is also requested to intimate the details of payments made and submit seven sets of compliance report on all the conditions stipulated in Stage-I approval alongwith all the necessary documents, certificates, undertakings etc for onward submission to the competent authority for issual of Stage II approval.

Transfer of Forest Land proposed for diversion to the User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final approval. This in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of (5) years. In the event of non compliance of the above conditions, this in-principle approval shall automatically stand revoked after (5) years.



With reference to the above it is submitted that, CA scheme was prepared and submitted for diversion of 17.50 Ha. of Forest land for Formation of road from Pankena to Kankanur 0/0 to 12/600 in Mahadevpur Division in favour of Superintending Engineer, R&B Regional Office Warangal Urban of Mahadevapur division of Jaya Shankar Bhupalpally District. The Compensatory Afforestation area is identified in Venkatapuram Division for raising Compensatory Afforestation in different Sy.Nos. 12/1 & 38/1 in Morravanigudem village, Venkatapuram Mandal, to an extent of 17.50 Ha. Range and Division Venkatapuram.

The Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, TS, Hyderabad has further instructed to the District Forest Officer/Forest Divisional Officer to issue the demand notice to the User Agency in consultation with Nodal Officer for Forests (Conservation) Act, 1980 for payment of Cost of CA etc., and issue the demand to the User Agency only after vetting by the Nodal Officer. The Compensatory Afforestation scheme is got approved from Nodal Officer FCA, o/o The Prl. Chief Conservator of Forest(HoFF), Telangana, Hyderabad vide reference 2nd cited above.
