

 A relative height, B.F. represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
 A relative height, e.g., 50, marked along a canal indicate the height of the top of the canal embankment of the adjacent country.
 Perennial streams in this sheet are fordable from October to June.
 Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to April.
 Wells and tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.
 The kilometre scale numbers along the roads, railways and canals are shown in plain type, e.g., 5, whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., 5.
 Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season.
