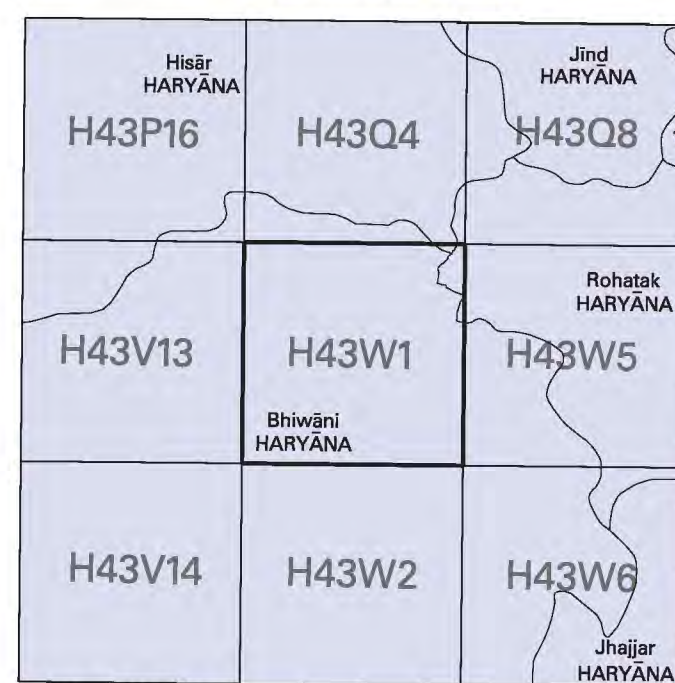

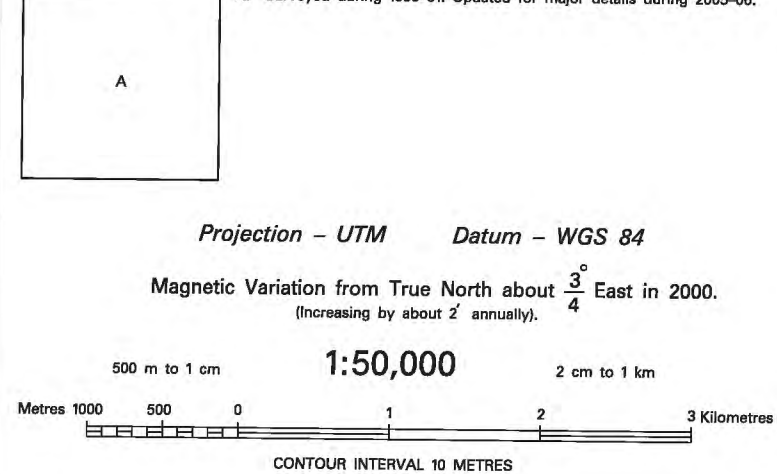

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
A relative height, e.g., 3r, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
Important government buildings are shown in black with names.
Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
Unsettled roads and cart-tracks in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use those along canals is required from the irrigation authorities.

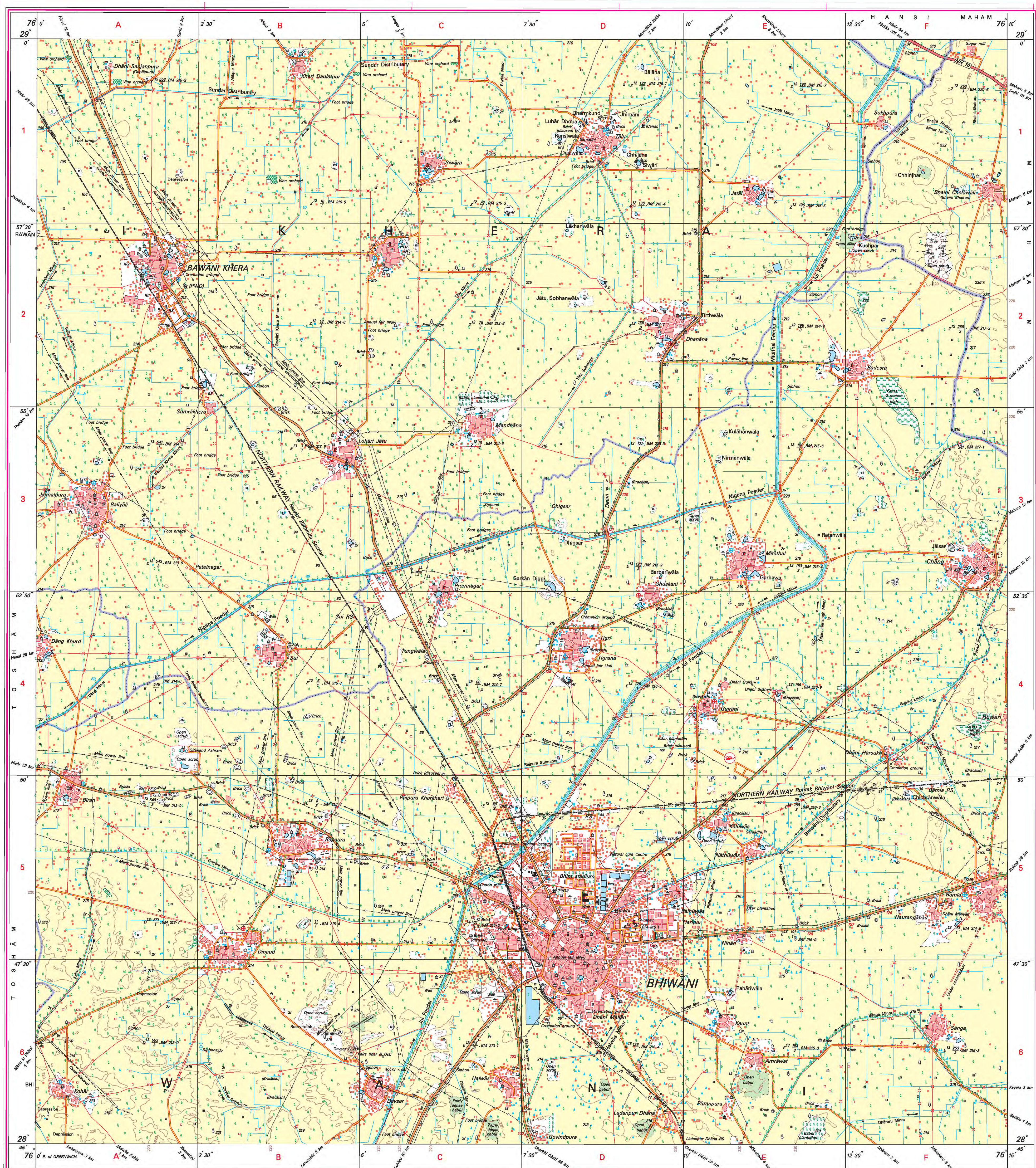
