NOTES:-Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.

A relative height, e.g., . 8r, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope. A relative height, e.g., 30r, against a well, indicates its total depth in metres. The kilometre stone numbers along road and railways are shown in slant type e.g., 5', whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type e.g., 5'.

Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December. Most of the unlined well symbols indicate covered tanks, called kunds, which usually contain surface collection of rainwater. Limits of cultivation are variable and dependent on rainfall.

Diggi is a tank which is used for collection of water. Pyāu is a place where there is arrangement for serving drinking water. Hand pump is shown thus......


