## TO WHOM SO EVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of environment and forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/88-FC(Pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act 2006 (FRA for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purpose, it is certified that 71,880 hectare of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Executive Engineer, Sanjay Sagar Project, Bah River Division, Ganj Basoda, District Vidisha (Name of user agency) for Semalkhedhi Teerth Minor Irrigation Project (Purpose for diversion of forest land) in Vidisha District falls within jurisdiction of Semalkhedhi village in Sironj Tehsil.

It is further certified that:

- The complete process for identification and settlement of right under the F.R.A. has been carried out for the entire 71,880 hectare of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultation and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure I to annexure III.
- The proposal for such diversion (with full detail of the project and its implication in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concern Gram Sabha of forest dwellers who eligible under the F.R.A.
- The each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/processes under the F.R.A. have been carried out and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and detail of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the Gram Sabha of Semalkhedhi village is enclosed as annexure I to annexure III.
- The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of the Gram Sabha present.
- The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the F.R.A. have been completed and the Gram Sabha have been their consent to it.
- The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(4)(e) of the F.R.A.
