 enclosed as annexure I to annexure III.
- (d) The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken pace only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of the Gram Sabha present.
- (e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under-section 3(2) of the F.R.A. have been completed and the Gram Sabhahaye been their consentro it.
- (f) The rights of Primitive Tribal. Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1)(e) of the F.R.A. Encl: As above.
