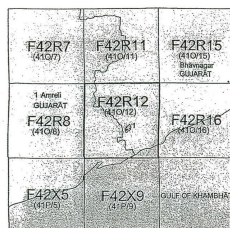


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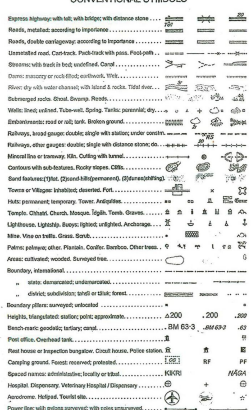

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CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

- Express highway with toll, with bridge, with distance stone
- Roads, metalled according to importance
- Unmetalled road, Cart track, Path track with cross, Foot path
- Stream with track in track, unmetalled, Canal
- Dam, masonry or rock filled, overflow, Wall
- River, dry with water channel, with island & note, Tidal river
- Submerged rocks, Shoal, Sandbar, Flats
- Wells, hand, covered, Tapped, Spring, Tanka, perched, etc.
- Embankment, road or rail, bank, broken ground
- Railways, broad gauge, double, single with station, under construction
- Railways, other gauges, double, single with distance stone, etc.
- Motor line or tramway, etc. Crossing with level
- Contours with sub-contours, Rocky slopes, Cliffs
