This is with reference to your memo no. 57759 dated 08/04/2022 thereby requesting for authority letter in favour of Executive Engineer (Sh. - (i) Further, it is observed that even after lapse of two years from the date of sanction, the work is yet to be awarded. In this regard, State PWD needs to examine the matter and fix responsibility for not awarding the work within stipulated time period.
- (ii) Moreover, State PWD needs to clarify/justify why not this work be de-sanctioned as the same could not be awarded within the prescribed time limit, keeping in view of the changes in the material/item rate.
