Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
Water features are shown in blue where they generally contain water.
A relative height, e.g., 50', represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
The kilometre stone numbers along the railway, roads and canals are shown in short type e.g., 47 whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., 57.
Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to March.
Tube wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
The area adjoining the Ghaghara River is liable to change owing to continual fluctuations in the course of the river.
Fences on the Ghaghara River take precedence traffic only.
