JUSTIFICATION FOR LOCATING THE PROJECT IN FOREST AREA

Government of Manipur is planning to develop Marjing hill area as a pony sanctuary and to showcase the state as the birth place of Polo and develop the site/complex as a spiritual tourism as well as eco-tourism spot. This includes erecting of a grand Manipuri Pony statue on top of the Marjing hill, in addition to improving the road leading to the site.

- Marjng hill is known to be a mythological sacred place related with Lord Sanamahi and the place is related with the taming of the Samudon Ayangba, the mythological horse.
- Considering the significance of the place and underlying huge tourism potential, the Ministry of Tourism has sanctioned the project "Development of Integrated Tourist Circuit for Marjing Polo-Kaina-Khebaching in Manipur".
