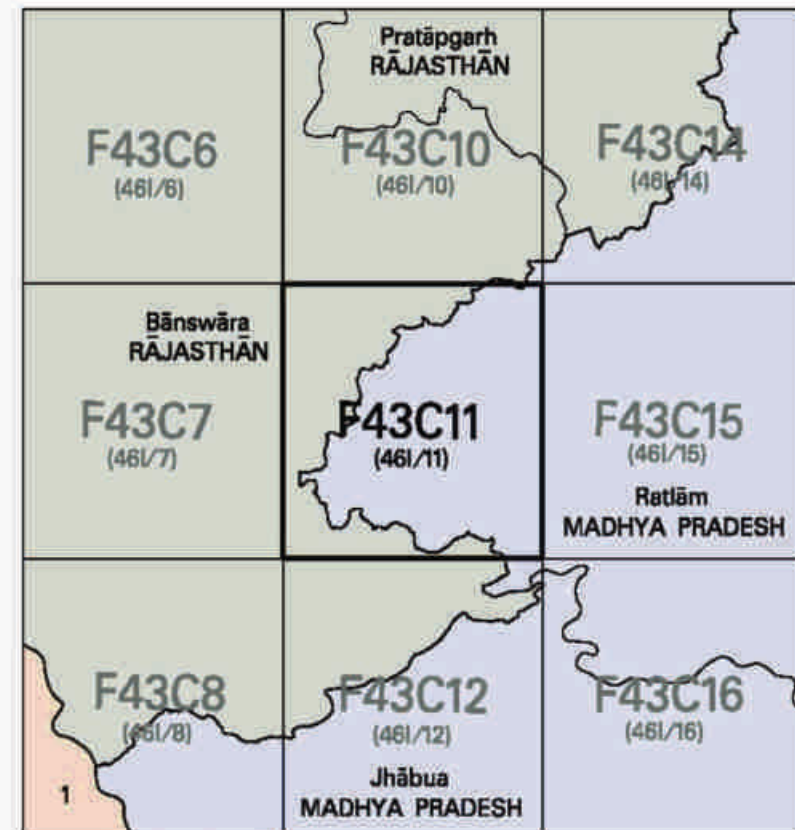

NOTES:-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
 Contours are approximate.
 A relative height, e.g., 50, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
 Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to January.
 Cultivation is periodic and dependent on rainfall.
 Unmetalled roads in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season.
 The state boundary between Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan States has been surveyed as pointed out by the local officials on the ground but has not been verified by the Government concerned.
 Digg is a tank which is used for collection of water.
 Hand Pump is shown thus:

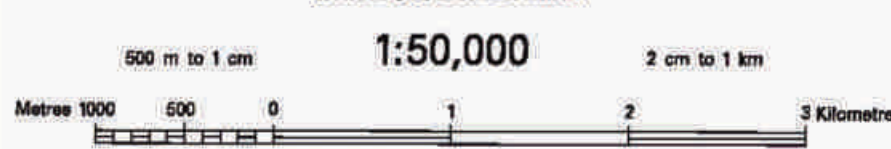
