In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purpose read with MoEF's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, It is certified that 6.728 hectares of land proposed to be diverted in favour of Executive Engineer Masonry Dam Division No.3 Deolond Distt. Shahdol for Construction of Bahuti Main Canal in Sidhi District falls within jurisdiction of Majhigawan, Sharda, Kariyajhar, Villages in Rampur Naikin Tehsil .

It is further certified that:-

- The complete process for identification and Settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 6.728 hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gramsabha (s), sub-Division Level Committee (s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed (s), as per annexure 01 to 04.
- The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabhas have given their consent to it;
- The proposal does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural Communities.
