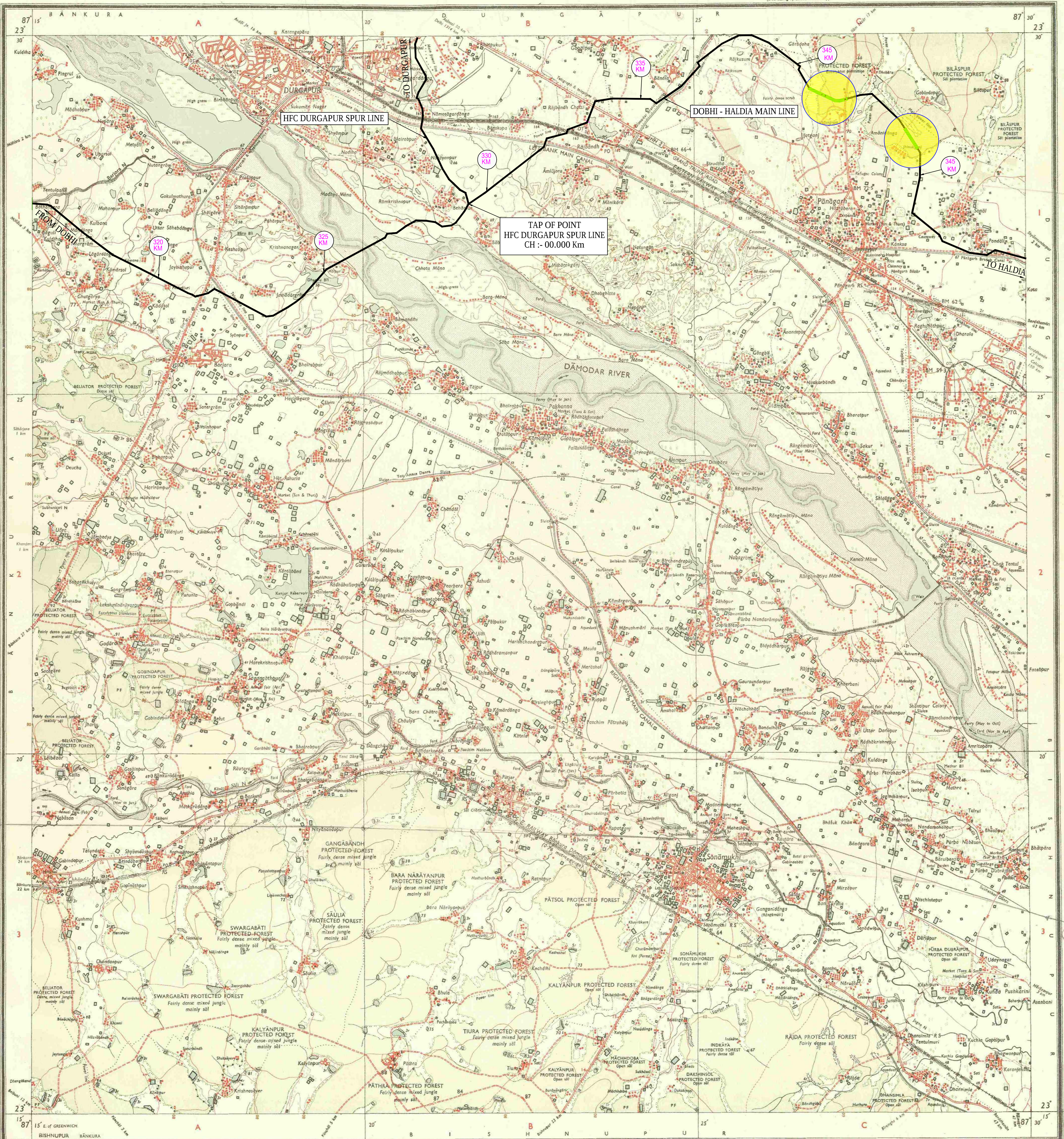

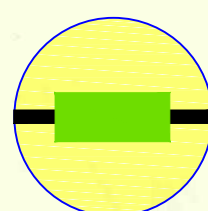

A relative height, dr, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
Wooded areas are coloured green. Scattered trees and other vegetation are in green, but prominent surveyed trees are in black.

Unmetalled roads in this sheet are motorable in dry season. Permission to use these along roads only is required from the Irrigation authorities.
The kilometre stone numbers along road and railways are shown in black type, e.g., 10, whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., 10.
A relative height, e.g., dr, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
