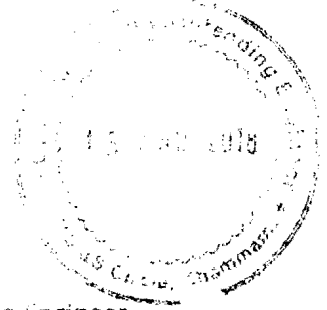

Sub: Forest Conservation Act - Diversion of 0.736 Ha of forest land in Reserve Forest of Khammam Division - for laying pipeline in segment - 25/10 (Yellandu Koragutta) for providing safe drinking water to Yellandu Constituency of Khammam District in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS & S) Circle, Khammam - In -Principle (Stage-I) approval accorded by Gol - Demand notice issued - Regarding.

It is informed that the Government of India, New Delhi vide reference 2nd cited, has accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 0.736 Ha of forest land in Khammam division for laying of pipeline in segment - 25/10 (Yellandu Koragutta) for providing safe drinking water to Yellandu Constituency of Khammam District in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS & S) Circle, Khammam (User Agency) duly stipulating certain conditions to be complied and communicated by the PCCF, TS, Hyd vide reference 1st cited.

In view of the above, it is requested to deposit the following payments towards NPV and other charges as shown below.

The NPV, CA etc amounts to be deposited into Adhoc CAMPA account through online mode. For this, the User Agency has to upload the demand against the project. After approval by the Nodal Officer, the User Agency shall generate the challan and make the payment against the challan generated. Step-by-step procedure is available at forestsclerance.nic.in.

Further, the User Agency has to deposit the following amount in PD Account of Forest Divisional Officer, Khammam. Account No 62420297901, SBH Gandhi Chowk Branch, Khammam.

The user agency is also requested to comply with the following in accordance with the GOI instructions issued vide F.No.7-23/2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide PCCF, AP, Hyderabad Rc.No.45921/2001-F4, Dated:23.08.2013, at the cost of the Project proponent:

- 3) Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safe guard imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers one in vernacular language and the other in English language so as to make people aware of permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non-forest purposes.
- 4) The copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

Other Conditions to be complied with by the User Agency:

1. The Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The demarcation of the proposed forest area proposed for diversion shall be carried out by erecting cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of user agency.
3. The Compensatory Afforestation (CA) shall be raised and maintained by the State Forest Department over 4.687 out of the 145.18 ha of Non-forest land identified in Sy. No. 100 of Nagilla Village at Madgul Mandal in Amangal Range of Amangal Division at the cost of user agency.
4. Identified CA land and approved CA Scheme shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
5. The CA area identified at Amangal Division which is apportioned project wise shall be treated as per the CA Scheme approved.

6. Non-Forest land identified for raising compensatory afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department before issue of the Stage - II clearance.
7. Non-Forest land which is transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department for the purpose of compensatory afforestation, shall be declared as Reserved Forest under Section 4 or Protected Forest under Section - 29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 or under the relevant Section (S) of the local Forest Act. The Nodal Officer must report compliance within a period of 6 months from the date of grant of final approval and send a copy of the original notification declaring the non-forest land under Section 4 or Section 29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927, or under the relevant section of the local Forest Act at the case may be, to this office for information and record.
8. The State Government shall charge the Net present Value of the diverted forest land measuring 4.687 ha from User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA Nos 826 in 566 with related IA's in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202/1995.
9. Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from User Agency.
10. The funds received from the User Agency towards Compensatory Afforestation and Net Present Value under this project including levies towards mitigation measures for wildlife conservation etc shall be deposited in the respective bank account of the Telanagana State CAMPA. The User Agency shall compulsorily deposit the CA and other levies only by generating challan through the Ministry's Website.
11. The muck generated in the earth cutting if any, shall be disposed off at designated dumping sites and in no case the muck/debris will be disposed off in the forest areas.
12. Tree felling in the proposed forest area shall be carried out wherever necessary, with the prior permission of the Divisional Forest Officer concerned.
13. State Forest Department shall carry out translocation of the trees wherever feasible at the cost of the User Agency.
14. Wherever necessary, user agency shall provide free supply of water for forest nurseries and field staff quarters and range officers, besides providing outlets with small troughs during summer for wild animals in forest areas.
15. The forest land proposed for diversion shall under no circumstances be transferred or sublet to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government.
16. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
17. The user agency shall use existing paths and roads for laying of pipeline and no new paths / roads are to be formed.
18. As recommended by the DFO, Khammam, the user agency shall erect two permanent boards at the entrance and exit point of the forest area proposed for diversion about status of the land.

19. Minimal disturbance should be ensured by creating labour camps outside the forest area as far as possible and it will be the responsibility of the UA to ensure that the labourer and staff engaged in execution of work do not destruct nearby forest flora and fauna.
20. The total forest area utilized for project shall not exceeded 4.687 ha and the forest area diverted shall not be used for any purpose other than those shown in the diversion proposal.
21. The user agency shall make provisions for supply of water to wildlife at designated places / along the route passing through forest areas, in consultation with Telangana Forest Department. Such provision should be made at intervals of 2 km each. The Chief Wildlife Warden is advised to develop a master plan to use the proposed pipelines for supply of water to the wildlife. Precautions have to be taken to avoid concentration of livestock at the water point.
22. The Progress of the Compensatory Afforestation as mentioned by the DFO, Khammam Division in Sl. No. 12 (v) (a) & (b) of Part II i.e. 8.54 ha of Forest land and 432.21 ha of non forest land and DFO, Kothagudem Division in Sl. No. 12 (v) (a) of part II i.e. 34.31 ha forest land shall be monitored by the Circle Head and a copy of such monitoring report shall be forwarded to the Regional Officer to upload the same in the web portal.
23. User agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
24. Any other conditions that the Central Government or Addl. Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests (Central) of Regional Office, Chennai may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency.
25. In the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the user agency is liable for penal action as decided by the Addl. Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests (Central), Regional Office, Chennai.
26. The User Agency shall pay an amount of Rs. 9,91,100/- (Rupees Nine lakhs Ninety one thousand one hundred only) towards Construction of Boundary Pillars, Cost of Boards - 2 Nos and Cost towards extraction of tree growth (the details are shown in the below table), to deposit the following amount in PD Account of Forest Divisional Officer, Khammam. Account No 62420297901, SBH Gandhi Chowk Branch, Khammam.

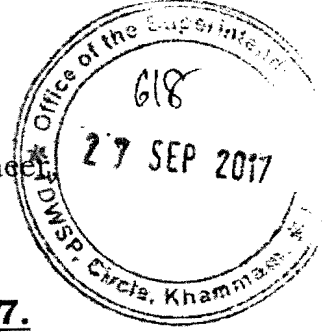

It is submitted that, the State Govt. vide reference 1st cited has accorded stage -I approval for 4.687 Ha of Forest land in erstwhile Kothagudem Division and Khammam forest divisions presently Yellandu and Khammam forest divisions in Kothagudem and Khammam Districts for laying of Pipeline and Construction of structures in Segment - 25/10 (Yellandu Koragutta) for providing safe drinking water under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle Khammam, subject to fulfillment of certain conditions stipulated therein.

Further, the PCCF,TS Hyd vide reference 2nd cited has issued instructions to raise demand note as per the actual rates and submit the demand note to the Nodel Officer on email (ccfcampa.apfd@gmail.com and dcffca@gmail.com) for vetting. Only after vetting of the demand note by the nodal officer, the Forest Divisional Officer, should raise the demand with the User Agency.
