OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Approval of Parvathi Bharti Mahasabha Project
Environmental Aspects

The Parvathi Project, Mahasabha was referred to the
Ministry for environmental clearance by the Central Water
Commission.

Due to non-furnishing of requisite details, the project was
not in April, 1986. The project authorities resubmitted the
table environmental information in June, 1987. On the basis
of examination of these details, the present authorities
are to prepare detailed action plan on the following:

- i. Rehabilitation Master Plan
- ii. Phased Catchment Area Treatment Scheme
- iii. Command Area Development
- iv. Compensatory Afforestation
- v. Flora and Fauna
- vi. Health aspects

The field surveys for various components are still under
progress. Details are expected to be made available by December, 1987.

Keeping into account various points, approval is accorded to
the project subject to the following conditions:

- i. Detailed studies/surveys as required by the Project
authority will be carried out according to the time
schedule given and details made available to the
department for consideration.
- ii. The action plans in respect of Catchment Area
Treatment, Command Area Development and Rehabilitation
will be completed and to be completed before the
filling up of the reservoir commences.
- iii. The minimum requirements for implementation of the
action plans as shown at (ii) above and also other
environmental safeguards must be strictly followed
in the project area.

16. Adequate fuel arrangements should be made for 50,000 people who are going to be employed in the construction work for a period of 6 years.

17. Special arrangements should be made regarding the entry of the labourers into the nearby forest areas for avoiding the damage to the vegetation cover. For this financial allocation be made in the budget estimate of the project at least to provide fuel wood to the labourers during the construction phase.

18. To prevent spread of communicable diseases, screening of the work force at the dam site should be done at project cost and a network of centres created for effective Health Delivery System.

19. A special Monitoring Committee be constituted with experts from various fields such as environment, watershed management, soil conservation, forestry etc. to oversee the effective implementation and implementation of various environmental action plans parallel with the construction work.

20. The Department should be kept informed about the progress made in various works every six months for reviewing and suggesting necessary changes if required.

21. Approval under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of forest land should be obtained before any work should be initiated prior to this approval.

22. During techno-economic clearance of the project, if in any change in scope or nature of the project from environmental examination of such nature will be necessary. This Department should be informed of the situation in due course.

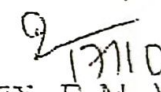
