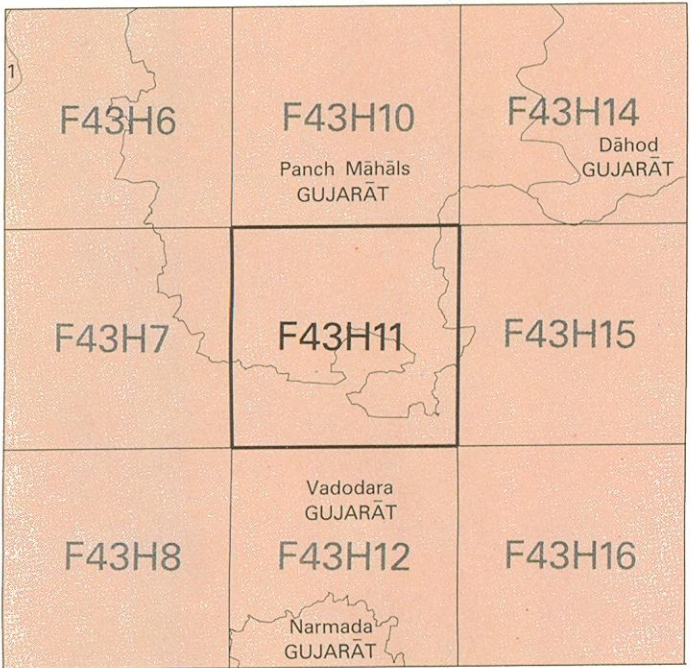

NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level. Contours are approximate.
A relative height e.g. 20, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
The interpolated heights and contours in this sheet have not been adjusted to the heights of the spirit-levelled bench-marks and may not be strictly in accordance with them.
Cart-tracks and unmetalled roads in the sheet against which there is no descriptive remark are generally passable in dry season. Cart-tracks generally exist along cart-tracks and field bunds.
The kilometre stone numbers along roads and railways are shown in slant type, e.g. 5, whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g. 5.
Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to February.
Periodical cultivation occurs in the non-perennial portion of Orsang River bed during summer.
Canal distance stones are 1000 metres apart and every fifth stone is shown.
Permission to use roads along canal is required from the irrigation authorities.
